Jammu And Kashmir's Renowned Pashmina Craft Receives GI Tag

- **Basohli Pashmina**, an age-old traditional craft originating from the picturesque district of **Kathua** in **Jammu and Kashmir**, has recently earned the prestigious **Geographical Indication (GI)** tag.
- Basohli Pashmina is renowned for its **exceptional softness, fineness, and feather-like weight**. Crafted by skilled artisans using traditional hand-spinning techniques, this exquisite fabric has been a symbol of luxury and elegance for over a century. Its hallmark is its remarkable ability to provide warmth without adding bulk, making it an ideal choice for cold climates and discerning fashion enthusiasts.
- The **Department of Industries and Commerce**, in collaboration with **NABARD Jammu and Human Welfare Association, Varanasi**, played a pivotal role in securing the GI tag for Basohli Pashmina. This achievement was the result of concerted efforts to preserve and promote this craft, recognizing its cultural significance and economic potential.



Bihar Caste Census Reveals Demographic Insights

- The Bihar government recently released the results of its caste survey, shedding light on the state's demographic composition. The survey provides valuable data on caste distribution in Bihar.
- **Here are the key findings from the Bihar caste survey:** Extremely Backward Class (EBC) comprises 36.01% of the population. Other Backward Class (OBC) constitutes 27.13% of the population.
- Scheduled Caste (SC) population stands at 19.65%. Scheduled Tribe (ST) population is 1.68%. General Caste population is 15.52%. Yadavs represent 14% of the population. Hindus make up 82% of the population. Muslims account for 17.71%.



Glacial Lake Burst In Sikkim Causes Devastation

- At least seven people have lost their lives, and a significant number remain injured or missing in the wake of flash floods that struck Sikkim on October 4. These devastating floods were triggered when a glacial lake, formed by the gradual melting of a Himalayan glacier, unexpectedly overflowed, leading to the inundation of the Teesta river basin.
- The floods originated from the sudden overflow of the South Lhonaklake, located at an altitude of approximately 5,200 meters above sea level. This catastrophic event resulted in the destruction of the Chungthang dam, a critical component of Sikkim's largest hydroelectric project, and caused extensive damage to highways, villages, and towns.



- The Chungthang dam, a concrete-rock structure, was breached at its center due to the force and speed of the surging water, estimated at nearly 54 kilometers per hour. The suddenness of the event left little time for warnings or preventive measures.

Coca-Cola India Rolls Out 100% Recycled PET Bottles For Small Packs

- Beverage company **Coca-Cola India** made a significant announcement on Wednesday, unveiling its latest sustainability initiative with the launch of **fully recycled PET bottles** for its flagship Coca-Cola brand.
- These bottles are available in pack sizes of **250 ml** and **750 ml**, and they are set to be distributed across various markets in the country. The move comes as part of Coca-Cola's global commitment to reducing its environmental footprint.
- This initiative is part of the company's broader sustainable packaging platform, which also includes a commitment to collect and recycle the equivalent of one bottle or can for every one sold globally by 2030. Furthermore, Coca-Cola aims to make **100% of its packaging recyclable by 2025**.



Sarakka Central Tribal University Approved For Telangana

- On **October 4th**, the Union Cabinet approved the establishment of a tribal university in **Telangana**, named **The Sarakka Central Tribal University**. This university, with a budget of **Rs 889 crore**, will be located in **Mulugu district**.
- The initiative was a commitment made by the Central government as a part of the **Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014**, which aimed to support both Andhra Pradesh and Telangana in establishing tribal universities.
- **Sammakka-Sarakka**, a mother-daughter duo, holds a special place in the local **tribal folklore**. Sammakka, married to PagididdaRaju, a Kakatiya dynasty chief, played a pivotal role in protesting against oppressive taxes imposed by local rulers. Sarakka, one of her daughters, lost her life in the battle, and Sammakka disappeared into the hills, believed to have transformed into a vermillion casket.



PMModi Inaugurated The Country's First High-Tech Sports Training Center

- **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** inaugurated the country's first high-tech sports training centre for Divyangjan, named after former **Prime Minister Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee**, in **Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh**.
- This initiative aims to provide equal opportunities in sports, enhance talent, and encourage participation in various sports disciplines. Divyangjan from all over the country can practice and train in the **Atal Bihari Training Center for Divyang Sports**.



- The AtalBihari Training Centre for Disability Sports is a state-of-the-art facility dedicated to training and nurturing athletes with disabilities. It houses world-class infrastructure and coaching staff to provide the best possible training environment for differently-abled athletes.

Centre Extends SBI Chairman Dinesh Khara's Tenure Until August 2024

- Centre has decided to extend the tenure of **Mr. Dinesh Khara** as the **Chairman of the State Bank of India (SBI)**, the nation's largest lender, until **August** of the following year. Mr. Khara's tenure, which began on **October 7, 2020**, for a three-year term, is now set to continue until he reaches the age of **63**.
- Mr. Khara has been the **Managing Director and CEO of SBI Mutual Fund** from November 2013 to August 2016. In August 2016, Mr. Khara was appointed as the **Managing Director (MD)** of the **State Bank of India**. Beyond his academic qualifications, Mr. Khara is also a **Certified Associate of the Indian Institute of Bankers (CAIIB)**.
- Dinesh Khara has a remarkable career trajectory within the State Bank of India. He embarked on his journey with the bank as a probationary officer in **1984**. He has played a pivotal role in overseeing the merger of **five associates and the BhartiyaMahila Bank with SBI**.



Nokia Opens 6G Lab Facility In Bengaluru

- Telecom giant **Nokia** has made a significant stride towards the future of wireless technology with the establishment of its state-of-the-art **6G lab** at the company's global R&D center in **Bengaluru, India**.

It could entail a focus on specific periods or aspects of India's history that are considered classical, offering a deeper exploration of the nation's past.

Mumbai Second Most Polluted Major Global City As Air Quality Worsens

- India is grappling with severe air pollution issues, with **Mumbai** ranking as the second most polluted city according to **IQAir**, a leading air quality measurement company. **Delhi**, the capital, also faces significant air quality challenges, ranking sixth globally. **The air quality index (AQI)** measures pollution levels, indicating the health risks associated with breathing the air
- Mumbai's **AQI reached 160**, far surpassing the safe limit, with fine particulate matter (PM2.5) concentration being **14.7 times** higher than the **World Health**

Organization's guidelines. **Delhi**, too, experienced dangerous pollution levels, exceeding the guidelines by 9.8 times.

- A study published in **The Lancet** revealed that around **1.6 million** deaths in India in 2019 were attributed to air pollution. The economic toll was staggering, amounting to billions of dollars in losses, with premature deaths accounting for **\$28.8 billion** and morbidity adding **\$8 billion** to the burden.

Skyroot Aerospace Unveils Vikram-1 Rocket, Scheduled For Full Launch Next Year

- Dr. Jitendra Singh, the Union Minister of Science and Technology, unveiled **Skyroot's Vikram-1 orbital rocket** in **Hyderabad** on Tuesday, October 24th. Dr. Singh also inaugurated Skyroot Aerospace's new global headquarters in **Hyderabad**, named **MAX-Q**.
- Skyroot's Vikram-1 is described as a "**technologically advanced**, multi-stage launch vehicle with a payload capacity of approximately **300 Kg** to Low Earth Orbit. It is an all-carbon-fiber-bodied rocket equipped with 3D printed liquid engines.
- **MAX-Q** is described as "the country's largest private rocket development facility under a single roof." MAX-Q is equipped with state-of-the-art infrastructure, encompassing integrated design, manufacturing, and testing facilities for space launch vehicles.



PM Modi To Attend The Installation Of Lord Ram's Idol At Ayodhya Temple On January 22

- According to the **360 ONE Wealth Hurun India Rich List for 2023** released recently, Reliance Industries chairman **Mukesh Ambani** has surged ahead of Adani Group’s **Gautam Adani** to claim the title of the **richest Indian**.
- Mukesh Ambani, the chairman of Reliance Industries, saw his wealth grow by a modest 2 percent, reaching a staggering **Rs 8.08 lakh crore**. This significant wealth increment has solidified his position as the wealthiest individual in India.

 - **Nepal: 69th**
 - **Sri Lanka: 60th**

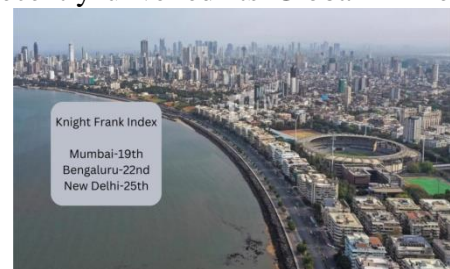

SC Refers Electoral Bond Case To 5-Judge Constitution Bench

- The **Supreme Court** decided to refer a group of petitions challenging the **electoral bond scheme** for political party funding to a five-judge **Constitution bench**. The bench, led by Chief Justice **D Y Chandrachud**, received an urgent application requesting a conclusive judgment. The matter is set to be heard on October 30.
- Electoral bonds are introduced as an alternative to providing cash donations to political parties. This change aims to make political funding more transparent and accountable.
- There are four **Public Interest Litigations (PILs)** pending on this issue, indicating the public interest and concern regarding the electoral bond scheme. One of the PIL petitioners had stated in March that a substantial amount, totaling **Rs 12,000 crore**, had been paid to political parties through electoral bonds.

Supreme Court Dismisses Appeal To Legalise Same-Sex Marriage

- India's **Supreme Court** recently made a significant decision, **declining an appeal to legalize same-sex marriages** in the country, dealing a blow to LGBTQ rights in one of the world's most populous nations.
- Chief Justice **Dhananjaya Yeshwant Chandrachud** emphasized that issues like same-sex marriage should be **within the domain of the parliament**, highlighting the court's commitment to steering clear of policy matters.
- Chandrachud also called for measures to prevent discrimination against LGBTQ individuals. This includes the **establishment of hotlines and safe houses for vulnerable members** of the LGBTQ community.



Jharkhand First State To Take Steps To Ensure Minimum Wages For Workers

- **Jharkhand** is making history by becoming the first state in India to take steps towards including gig workers, such as **Swiggy, Zomato, Ola, Uber, and Rapido employees**, under the ambit of minimum wages. This initiative is a significant move towards ensuring fair compensation for those in the gig economy.
- Jharkhand's groundbreaking move to consider minimum wages for gig workers and review minimum wage standards for other laborers is a significant step toward ensuring fair compensation for workers in various sectors. A committee has been formed by the Jharkhand State Minimum Wage Advisory Council, under the state's labor department, to address this issue.
- The primary objective of this committee is to study the working conditions of gig workers, including those in the delivery and ride-hailing services. Based on their findings, the committee will make recommendations regarding minimum wages for these workers.

India And UK Hold First 2+2 Foreign And Defence Dialogue In New Delhi

- The inaugural **India-UK '2+2' foreign and defence dialogue** was held in New Delhi. The dialogue saw both sides focusing on ways to enhance cooperation in **various critical areas** such as trade and investment, defense, critical technologies, civil aviation, health, and energy.
- In addition to bilateral cooperation, the dialogue also delved into international developments, with particular



attention to the **Indo-Pacific region**. Both countries share a vision for peace, stability, and prosperity in the Indo-Pacific, emphasizing the importance of a free, open, and inclusive region.

- The dialogue explored the possibility of enhancing collaboration in areas such as **counterterrorism, Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR)**, and **maritime security**. 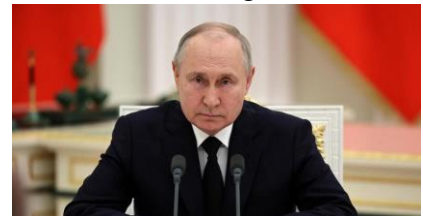
Tallest Statue Of B.R. Ambedkar To Be Unveiled In North America On October 14

- Standing at a towering height of **19 feet**, the 'Statue of Equality' is a testament to the enduring impact of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar's work. This monumental sculpture is poised to become the **largest statue of Babasaheb** outside of India.
- The 'Statue of Equality' is the creation of the distinguished artist and sculptor **Ram Sutar**. Mr. Sutar is renowned for his exceptional craftsmanship and previously sculpted the iconic 'Statue of Unity' dedicated to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.



Burevestnik Missile: Russia's Nuclear Missiles Can Now Reach Targets In US

- Russian President **Vladimir Putin** recently announced the successful testing of a new nuclear-powered missile called "**Burevestnik**" during a speech that covered various topics, including nuclear weapons and international relations.
- The **Burevestnik** is a ground-launched, **low-flying cruise missile** with the capability to carry a nuclear warhead. What sets it apart is its nuclear propulsion, which allows it to remain airborne for an extended period and cover vast distances.
- The International Institute for Strategic Studies suggested in 2021 that the Burevestnik missile could have a theoretical range of up to **20,000 kilometers**, making it capable of striking targets in the **United States** from various locations in **Russia**. Additionally, the missile operates at a low altitude (**50-100 meters**), making it challenging for air-defense radar systems to detect.



Russia Delivers Uranium For Bangladesh's Rooppur Nuclear Power Plant

- **Bangladesh** recently received its first shipment of **uranium from Russia**, which will be used to fuel the country's **Rooppur nuclear power plant**. The plant, financed and constructed by **Russia's Rosatom**, is a significant project aimed at enhancing Bangladesh's electrical grid and supporting its growing economy.
- **The Rooppur** power plant, located in **Ishwardi, Bangladesh**, will generate **2,400 megawatts** of electricity when both units are fully operational. This capacity will provide electricity to approximately **15 million** households in Bangladesh, making a substantial contribution to the nation's energy needs.
- Russia has funded the construction of the Rooppur power plant with an **\$11.38 billion** loan. Bangladesh will begin repaying this loan over a period of two decades, starting in **2027**. Once the Rooppur plant begins production, Bangladesh will join the ranks of over 30 countries with operational nuclear power reactors.



Escalation Of Israel-Palestine Conflict: "Operation Al-Aqsa Flood" Unleashed By Hamas Sparks Widespread Violence

- The Israel-Palestine conflict has escalated dramatically as Hamas, the armed Palestinian group, initiated "**Operation Al-Aqsa Flood**," firing over 5,000 rockets into Israel. The situation quickly escalated into a full-scale war, resulting in significant casualties and widespread fear among civilians.
- Israeli Prime Minister **Benjamin Netanyahu** declared a state of war, emphasizing the seriousness of the situation. He asserted that this was not a mere operation but a full-blown war. Netanyahu vowed that Hamas would face an unparalleled retaliation.
- The conflict between **Israel and Palestinian militants**, particularly Hamas, dates back to 2007. The latest escalation followed heightened tensions, exacerbated by Israel's closure of borders to Gazan workers. The conflict's toll included both combatants and civilians, with a significant number of casualties reported on both sides.



World's Second Largest Hindu Temple Outside India Inaugurated In US

- The **Swaminarayan Akshardham** temple in **Robbinsville Township, New Jersey**, was inaugurated on **8th October 2023**, under the guidance of its spiritual head, **Mahant Swami Maharaj**.
- Measuring an impressive **255ft x 345ft x 191ft**, the **New Jersey Akshardham** temple is the **second largest temple globally**, only surpassed by **Cambodia's Angkor Wat**.
- This temple represents the third Akshardham, meaning the '**abode of the divine**,' constructed by the organization, following two others in **New Delhi** and **Gujarat**, where BAPS is headquartered.

Biden Orders US Ships, Warplanes To Move Closer To Israel

- Amidst a recent attack by the **Palestinian terrorist organization Hamas**, President **Joe Biden** has promptly demonstrated solidarity with **Israel**. Given its role as a key arms provider to Israel, the United States is dispatching military reinforcements and aid to strengthen Israel's defense capabilities.
- The Pentagon's move to send the aircraft carrier USS Gerald R. Ford and accompanying warships to the eastern Mediterranean, strengthening fighter aircraft squadrons in the region to bolster Israel's defense.
- The rapid provision of additional equipment and resources, including munitions, to the **Israel Defense Forces**, reaffirms the United States' unwavering support for Israel and its people.



Israel Imposes Total Siege On Gaza

- **Hamas** launched a surprise offensive, leading to **Israeli airstrikes on Gaza**. Dozens of Palestinians killed and wounded, with over **570 casualties** reported. More than **123,000 people** displaced in Gaza due to the conflict.
- **Israel** imposed a total siege on the **Gaza Strip** and cut off water supply following a surprise offensive by **Hamas**. The conflict has escalated, causing civilian casualties and displacement.
- Israeli Prime Minister **Benjamin Netanyahu** vowed a strong response, threatening to turn Hamas sites to rubble. Israel imposed a complete siege on Gaza, impacting **2.3 million people**: no electricity, food, water, or gas.



Sri Lanka To Take Over As Chair Of Indian Ocean Rim Association

- **Sri Lanka** to take over as **Chair of IORA** for the next two years. Foreign Ministers of 16 countries will attend IORA meeting in Colombo including Foreign Ministers of **India, Bangladesh, Mauritius, Iran, Malaysia, and South Africa**.
- The **IORA** Council of Ministers meeting is the highest decision-making body of the Association. It is held annually to discuss and decide on IORA priorities.
- The **Indian Ocean Rim Association (IORA)** is an intergovernmental organisation of **23** member states and **11** dialogue partners from **Africa, West Asia, South Asia, South-East Asia, and Oceania**. It was established in **1997** to promote regional cooperation and development.



What Is Hamas, The Palestinian Militant Group?

- In **October 2023**, **Hamas**, an **Islamist militant group** governing the **Gaza Strip**, launched a massive surprise attack on **southern Israel**, killing hundreds of civilians and soldiers and taking dozens as hostages.
- Hamas, short for **Harakat al-Muqawama al-Islamiya (Islamic Resistance Movement)**, was founded in **1987** by **Sheikh Ahmed Yassin**, a Palestinian cleric with ties to the Muslim Brotherhood.
- It emerged during the first intifada as the political arm of the Brotherhood in Gaza. It gained popularity for the social services it provided and as a rejection of **Fatah's** perceived corruption.
- Since Israel's withdrawal from Gaza in **2005**, Hamas has been the de facto authority in the territory. It won a majority in the PA's legislature in **2006** and established its government.

Putin In Kyrgyzstan For First Trip Abroad Since ICC Arrest Warrant

- Russian President **Vladimir Putin** embarked on his first foreign trip since the **International Criminal Court (ICC)** issued an arrest warrant for him in March, raising international attention and scrutiny. The visit took place in **Kyrgyzstan**, a **Central Asian nation** historically tied to **Moscow**.
- During his meeting with **Kyrgyz President Sadyr Japarov**, Putin emphasized Russia's significance as Kyrgyzstan's top trade partner and largest investor, reaffirming their commitment to mutual cooperation.
- As part of his visit, Putin participated in a ceremony marking the **20th anniversary** of **Russia's Kant military airbase**, strategically located outside **Bishkek**. This outpost serves as a crucial tool for Moscow to project power in the region, underscoring Russia's geopolitical interests in Central Asia.



World Health Summit 2023

- The **2023 World Health Summit** took place from October 15 to October 17 under the theme "**A Defining Year for Global Health Action**" in Berlin, Germany, and online.
- This summit fosters international collaboration and open discourse rooted in scientific insights, placing global health at the forefront of political agendas and advancing the global health conversation in alignment with the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
- **Non-communicable diseases (NCDs)** have emerged as a significant **global health challenge**, demanding immediate attention and a multi-faceted approach this year.



PM To Inaugurate Global Maritime India Summit 2023 In Mumbai

- Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi will virtually inaugurate the **third edition** of the **Global Maritime India Summit 2023 (GMIS 2023)**, set to be held from 17th to 19th October at MMRDA Grounds in **Mumbai**.
- This prestigious maritime event is organized by the **Ministry of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways** and promises to be a significant gathering for the global maritime community.

- **GMIS 2023** provides the ideal platform for unveiling ‘**Amrit Kaal Vision 2047**,’ a comprehensive 25-year roadmap for India’s maritime blue economy. This visionary plan outlines strategic initiatives aimed at enhancing port facilities, promoting sustainable practices, and fostering international collaboration

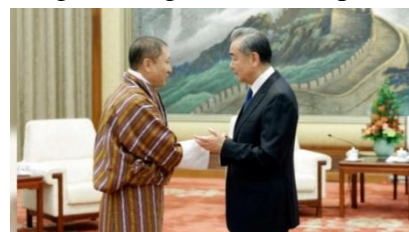
Biden’s Visit To Israel Amid Ongoing Conflict

In **Amman**, he will meet with Jordan’s King Abdullah, Egyptian President **Abdel Fattah el-Sisi**, and the Palestinian Authority President **Mahmoud Abbas**, who opposes Hamas and governs the **West Bank**.



Bhutan And China Make Progress In Border Talks

- **China and Bhutan** are working towards resolving their longstanding border disputes. Bhutan’s foreign minister visited **Beijing** for talks with his Chinese counterpart, indicating progress in the negotiation process.
- China has disputes with only two of its 14 neighboring countries – **India and Bhutan**. Bhutan and China have ongoing border disputes since the 1980s, specifically in areas like **Jakarlung, Pasamlung, and Doklam**.
- Bhutan maintains that discussions about tri-junction points (involving **India, China, and Bhutan**) can only happen after India and China resolve their border issues. Bhutan is observing how India and China settle their disputes before initiating comprehensive talks regarding tri-junction points.



Understanding The Indian Ocean Rim Association (IORA) And Its Significance

- **The Indian Ocean Rim Association (IORA)** recently convened its Council of Ministers meeting in **Colombo on October 11**, drawing interest from countries worldwide. Its genesis can be traced back to a speech by former South African President **Nelson Mandela** during a visit to **India in 1995**.
- With **23 member nations** and **11 dialogue partners**, IORA plays a crucial role in fostering regional cooperation around the **Indian Ocean**. These countries include **African, West Asian, South Asian, South East Asian, Australian, and Indian Ocean littoral states**.

- **The Indian Ocean Region** holds immense importance due to its geographical, economic, and strategic relevance. Approximately one-third of the world's population, totaling **2.6 billion** people, resides in this region.

India To Surpass Japan In 2030 To Become 2nd Largest Economy Of Asia, Says S&P Global

- By 2030, India's **Gross Domestic Product (GDP)** is predicted to reach a whopping **\$7.3 trillion**, making it the **second-largest economy** in the **Asia-Pacific region**, just after **China**.
- India's GDP, when measured in United States dollars (USD), is predicted to jump from \$3.5 trillion in 2022 to \$7.3 trillion by 2030. This rapid expansion will make India's economy second only to China in the Asia-Pacific region.
- In 2021 and 2022, India experienced rapid economic growth. In 2023, the strong growth trend continued, with the GDP expanding by **7.8% year-on-year** from April to June. This growth remains impressive despite the high comparison base established by the GDP growth of **13.1%** in the same quarter in 2022.



India Partially Resumes Visa Services For Canadians

- India has now decided to resume visa services for Canadians in four categories: **entry, business, medical reasons, and conferences**. **Emergency cases** will continue to be considered.
- **The India-Canada** relationship faced difficulties due to a dispute over the killing of a **Sikh separatist in British Columbia**. As a result of the strained ties, India suspended visa services for Canadians worldwide.
- The High Commission of India in **Ottawa** and Indian consulates in **Toronto** and **Vancouver** temporarily halted these services, citing **“safety and security considerations.”**



Dr S. Jaishankar Reaches Bishkek For 22nd SCO Council Of Heads Of Government Meeting

- Indian External Affairs Minister **S. Jaishankar** recently visited **Kyrgyzstan** for a two-day trip. This visit also includes Jaishankar's participation in a meeting of the **Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO)**.
- Jaishankar engaged in discussions with Kyrgyz President **Sadyr Zhaparov** to explore opportunities for enhancing cooperation in **banking, defense, and energy sectors**. They discussed a wide range of areas such as banking, energy, health, pharmaceuticals, defense, agriculture, and investments.
- Jaishankar will participate in the SCO Council of **Heads of Government (CHG)** meeting hosted by **Kyrgyzstan**. This meeting will include key figures like the Russian Foreign Minister **Sergey Lavrov** and the Chinese Foreign Minister **Wang Yi**.



- This visit reflects India's commitment to maintaining and strengthening diplomatic ties within the SCO framework. It aims to promote regional cooperation and meaningful dialogue among member states.

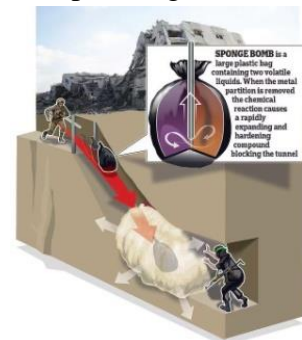
Republican Mike Johnson Elected New US House Speaker

- **Mike Johnson**, a relatively lesser-known Republican from Louisiana, has taken the elected as the new speaker of the **US House of Representatives**. He is the first Louisianan to become speaker and the first southerner to serve as speaker since Republican Newt Gingrich of Georgia in the 1990s.
- Johnson was elected to the Louisiana statehouse in 2015 and ran for Congress successfully in 2016. He now represents Louisiana's fourth congressional district. He describes himself as a "Christian, a husband, a father, a life-long conservative, constitutional law attorney and a small business owner".
- The United States House of Representatives, commonly referred to as the House, is one of the two chambers of the United States Congress, the other being the Senate. It plays a crucial role in the legislative process of the United States and is a fundamental component of the country's federal government.



Sponge Bombs: Israel's Secret Weapon Against Hamas

- As the conflict between Israel and Hamas escalates, Israeli forces are planning to use an innovative type of bomb referred to as "**sponge bombs**." These sponge bombs have the capability to **seal off the intricate network of tunnels** beneath Gaza without causing explosions.
- Gaza is riddled with an underground infrastructure that reaches **depths of 40-50 meters**. This extensive network includes bunkers, headquarters, storage facilities, and is connected to over a thousand rocket launch sites. These tunnels come in diverse forms, with some stretching for **hundreds of kilometers** and descending as deep as 80 meters below the 360-square-kilometer coastal strip and its surrounding borders.
- "**Sponge bombs**" are explosive devices designed to produce a sudden release of expanding foam that subsequently hardens. The devices are typically encased in protective plastic, with a **metal barrier separating two distinct liquids**. Upon activation, these liquids mix and move towards their intended target. In 2021, during exercises conducted in a simulated tunnel system near the Gaza border, the Israel Defense Forces (IDF) were observed using these devices.



CCI Becomes A Member Of International Competition Network Committee

- The **Competition Commission of India (CCI)** has achieved a significant milestone by becoming a part of the prestigious **18-member steering committee** of the **International Competition Network (ICN)**.
- The ICN, which comprises **140 competition agencies** from around the world, is a unique global body dedicated exclusively to competition law enforcement. Its primary purpose is to provide antitrust authorities with a specialized



and informal platform for **maintaining regular contacts and addressing practical competition concerns**.

- The Competition Commission of India's inclusion in the ICN's steering committee is a testament to the regulator's consistent efforts in the field of competition law enforcement. **India's commitment to promoting fair competition** and its proactive engagement in international dialogues have earned it a place among the select few competition authorities that guide the ICN's global initiatives.

Turkish Republic's 100th Anniversary Celebration

- Turkish Republic celebrated its **100th anniversary**, marking a century since its establishment as a modern, secular state following the collapse of the Ottoman Empire.
- Turkey is a transcontinental country located mainly on the Anatolian Peninsula in Western Asia, with a smaller portion in southeastern Europe. It is bordered by eight countries, including Greece, Bulgaria, Georgia, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Iran, Iraq, and Syria.
- **Ankara** is the capital of Turkey, while **Istanbul** is its largest city and economic hub **Turkish** is the official language of Turkey. The currency of Turkey is the **Turkish Lira (TRY)**.



EU Report Recommends 2% Global Wealth Tax On Billionaires To Curb Evasion

- The European Union Tax Observatory has published the 'Global Tax Evasion Report 2024,' calling for a **2% global wealth tax** on billionaires. The report emphasizes the urgent need to combat tax evasion, which enables some billionaires to effectively pay between 0% to 0.5% of their wealth in taxes.
- The report advocates for the implementation of a global minimum tax on billionaires, set at 2% of their wealth. This measure is expected to address tax evasion and generate approximately **\$250 billion from fewer than 3,000 individuals**.



India Ranks Third In Fintech Unicorns, With United States At The Top

- According to global research firm **Statista**, India has secured the **third position** in the global fintech landscape with **17 fintech unicorns**. India's top profitable companies include **Zerodha, Billdesk, Paytm, and Paytm**.

The US is home to an impressive **134 fintech unicorns**, producing the highest value in the industry. Meanwhile, the **UK ranks second** with **27 fintech unicorns**, making a substantial mark on the global fintech stage.
- China, despite having only eight fintech unicorns, has secured the **fourth position**. Giants like **Tencent** and **Ant Financial** have played a pivotal role in elevating China's overall financial market capitalization to \$338.92 billion.

Indian Air Force Unveils New Ensign On Its 91st Anniversary

- The **Indian Air Force (IAF)** celebrated its **91st anniversary** at the Bamrauli Air Force Station in Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh. The occasion was marked by the unveiling of the **new IAF ensign** by Air Chief Marshal V.R. Chaudhari.
- This significant event witnessed several historic firsts, including the inclusion of the Air Force crest and the first-ever woman officer to command the Air Force Day Parade. Group Captain ShalizaDhami made history as the **first woman officer to command the Air Force Day Parade**.
- One of the notable features of the celebration was the introduction of the new IAF ensign. The key change is the **addition of the Air Force crest**, which now graces the top right corner of the ensign, towards the fly side. This symbolic addition reinforces the IAF's commitment to its identity and heritage.



Indian Air Force Set To Induct Astra BVR Air-To-Air Missile

- The **Indian Air Force (IAF)** is making significant strides towards enhancing its air defense capabilities with the impending induction of indigenous **Astra Beyond Visual Range (BVR) Air-to-Air Missiles**. IAF To Stop Flying MiG-21 By 2025: Air Chief Marshal VR Chaudhari

- Amidst its ongoing efforts to modernize and replace its aging **Russian-origin aircraft**, the Indian Air Force (IAF) has announced plans to retire its iconic **MiG-21 fighter jets** and replace them with the indigenous **Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Mark 1A**.

- The history of **SAMPRITI** dates back to **2009**, when it was first established as a platform for joint military exercises between India and Bangladesh. Over the past decade, this initiative has witnessed substantial growth, becoming a symbol of the strong defence ties between the two nations.



First Ever Mobile Tower Installed At Siachen Glacier By The Indian Army

- The **Siachen Glacier**, known as the **world’s highest battlefield**, has witnessed a groundbreaking development with the installation of a mobile tower. The **Fire and Fury Corps** of the Indian Army, in collaboration with **Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL)**, achieved this remarkable feat, bringing enhanced mobile communication to soldiers deployed at elevations exceeding **15,500 feet**.
- The “**Siachen Warriors**” in partnership with BSNL erected the first-ever **BSNL Base Transceiver Station (BTS)** at forward posts in the Siachen Glacier region. - The Cambrian Patrol Competition, **organized by the UK Army**, challenges participants to navigate a demanding **60 km course** in the rugged terrains of Wales, UK. This course



includes troublesome mountains and swamplands. The teams are tasked with completing this formidable course in **less than 48 hours**, all while executing tactical missions, making it one of the **most challenging military exercises** in the world.

Indian Navy Gets Third Guided Missile Destroyer Imphal

- In a significant development for the **Indian Navy**, the state-of-the-art stealth guided missile destroyer, **Yard 12706 (Imphal)**, has been officially transferred to **Indian Navy on October 20, 2023**.

- **Imphal** which is **designed by the Indian Navy's Warship Design Bureau (WDB)** and **constructed by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders** stands as a symbol of India's prowess in indigenous shipbuilding.

Iron Sting Weapon Israel

- **Israeli forces** have introduced the cutting-edge "**Iron Sting**" system, designed to neutralize rocket launchers with remarkable accuracy, marking the first-ever use of this technology.
- The Magellan unit, in collaboration with the Air Force, has successfully thwarted dozens of terrorists using various weapons, including the innovative and highly precise mortar bomb known as "**Steel Sting**."
- This deployment is expected to revolutionize ground warfare by providing military units with organic, effective firepower while minimizing collateral damage and civilian casualties.



EU And India Conduct Maiden Joint Naval Exercise In The Gulf Of Guinea

- In a significant display of international cooperation, **India and the European Union (EU)** recently carried out their **first** joint naval exercise in the **Gulf of Guinea**, aimed at strengthening maritime security in the region.

- These collaborative activities underscored the mutual commitment of India and the EU to assist coastal states and uphold maritime security in the Gulf of Guinea. They highlighted the extensive and dynamic nature of EU-India cooperation in the realm of maritime security.



Indian Army And Air Force Contingent Set Off For 'Exercise KAZIND-2023'

- A contingent from the Indian Army and Indian Air Force, comprising 120 personnel, embarked on a mission to Kazakhstan today. Their objective is to participate in the **7th edition** of the Joint Military '**Exercise KAZIND-2023.**' This collaborative endeavor will take place in Otar, Kazakhstan, spanning from **30th October to 11th November 2023.**
- The Indian Army contingent, led by a Battalion from the **DOGRA Regiment**, consists of 90 personnel. Alongside them, 30 Air Force personnel from both sides will also actively partake in this year's Exercise.

This year, it has reached a new milestone by evolving into a bi-service exercise, including the Air Force component.

- The bench led by Justice SK Kaul told Attorney General for India R Venkataramani that the proposal for appointment of Chief Justice of a "sensitive" High Court (alluding to the Manipur High Court) is also among the pending resolutions.
- In a related development, the Supreme Court collegium last week recommended the transfer of Justice MV Muralidaran, who is presently the Acting Chief Justice of the Manipur High Court, to Calcutta High Court.

Arindam Bagchi Appointed As India's Ambassador To UN In Geneva

- **Arindam Bagchi**, currently serving as Additional Secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs, has been appointed as **India's next Ambassador/Permanent Representative** to the United Nations and other International Organisations in Geneva.

Nobel Prize In Literature 2023 Awarded To Jon Fosse

- **The Nobel Prize in Literature 2023** was awarded to **Norwegian author Jon Fosse or Jon Olav Fosse**, “for his innovative plays and prose which give voice to the unsayable”.
- The Nobel Prize in Literature is awarded by the Swedish Academy, Stockholm, Sweden. The Nobel Prize amount for 2023 is set at Swedish kronor (SEK) 11.0 million per full Nobel Prize.
- Jon Fosse, born in 1959, is widely considered one of the most important writers of our time. For almost forty years he has written novels, plays, poems, stories, essays, and children’s books. His award-winning work has been translated into more than fifty languages, and his plays have been staged over a thousand times all over the world.
- The Nobel Prize in Literature has been awarded 115 times to 119 Nobel Prize laureates between 1901 and 2022. The Nobel medal in literature was designed by Swedish sculptor and engraver Erik Lindberg and represents a young man sitting under a laurel tree who, enchanted, listens to and writes down the song of the Muse.

Nobel Peace Prize 2023 Awarded To NargesMohammadi

- The Norwegian Nobel Committee has decided to award the Nobel Peace Prize for 2023 to **NargesMohammadi** for her fight against the oppression of women in Iran and her fight to promote human rights and freedom for all.
- However, her brave struggle has come with tremendous personal costs. Altogether, the regime has arrested her 13 times, convicted her five times, and sentenced her to a total of 31 years in prison and 154 lashes.
- This year’s peace prize also recognises the hundreds of thousands of people who, in the preceding year, have demonstrated against Iran’s theocratic regime’s policies of discrimination and oppression targeting women. The motto adopted by the demonstrators – **“Woman – Life – Freedom”** – suitably expresses the dedication and work of NargesMohammadi.

Nobel Prize 2023 In Economic Sciences Awarded To Claudia Goldin

- The **SverigesRiksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel 2023** was awarded to **Claudia Goldin** “for having advanced our understanding of women’s labour market outcomes”.

- Yuvraj Singh, a cricketing legend, had held the record for the fastest fifty by an Indian for 16 years, with his fifty coming off 12 balls during the inaugural T20 World Cup in 2007 against England. However, Ashutosh Sharma changed the narrative with an astonishing performance.

- **Tata Motors** initially invested in the **Singur project** to create the "people's car" at an affordable **₹1 lakh price** tag. The company moved its manufacturing unit to **Sanand, Gujarat**, after abandoning the Singur project in 2008. The Sanand facility still operates for other Tata Motors passenger vehicles after the **Nano project** was discontinued in **2018**.

This was India's 14th gold at the Games. The Indian athlete overtook Japan's RirikaHironaka in the last 20-25 metres of the race to claim the yellow metal.

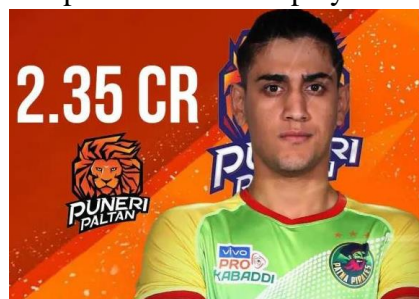


Closing Ceremony Marks The End Of The 19th Asian Games In Hangzhou

- Rohit Sharma completed his hundred off **63 balls**, fetching him the record for the fastest century ever by an Indian in the history of World Cup. First, he completed 1000 runs in World Cup, becoming only the fourth Indian to the landmark after Tendulkar, Virat Kohli and Sourav Ganguly and then struck three sixes to become the leading six-hitter in international cricket, surpassing 'Universe Boss's Chris Gayle.

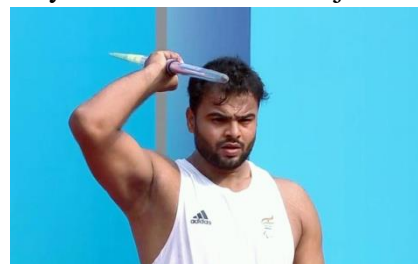


Shubman Gill Becomes Fastest Batter To Score 2000 Runs In ODIs

- Other winners in paralympics include: **Ankur Dhama**, who made history by becoming the **first Indian to claim two gold medals in a single edition** of the Asian Para Games. **Sundar Singh Gurjar**, another Indian athlete who not only won the **gold medal in the men's F46 javelin throw** but also set a new world record with a remarkable throw of **68.60 meters**.



India Grabs 111 Medals At The 4th Asian Para Games

- Indian para-athletes achieved a historic milestone at the Asian Para Games in Hangzhou with India achieving their most impressive medal count to date, amassing a total of **111 medals: 29 gold, 31 silver, and 51 bronze**.

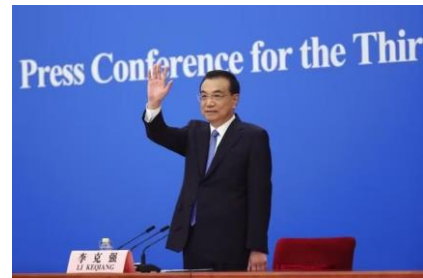
First Black Action Hero, Richard Roundtree Passed Away At 81

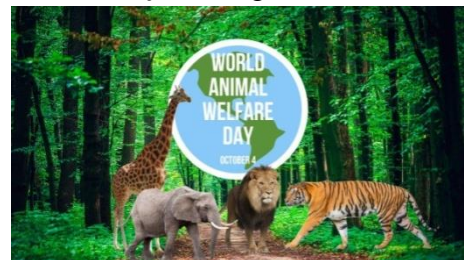
Important Days with theme

- National Space Day will serve as a source of inspiration for young minds, motivating them to pursue careers in STEM fields, ultimately bolstering India's prowess in the space sector.

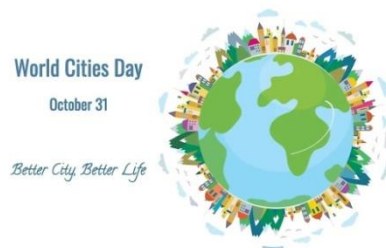
Accession Day 2023
