MOCI Minister Piyush Goyal Launched Bharat Startup Ecosystem Registry, Website & Logo of Startup Mahakumbh

Union Minister **Piyush Goyal**, Ministry of Commerce and Industry (MOCI) unveiled a new database for India's startup ecosystem, named **Bharat Startup Ecosystem Registry**, a **website**, and **logo** of 'Startup Mahakumbh' during the curtain raiser event of the **first-ever** 'Startup Mahakumbh'.



- The registry will act as a single platform database for startups, investors, incubators, and other stakeholders in India's startup ecosystem.
- The event was organised by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), under MOCI.

Startup Mahakumbh:

- i. The first-ever 'Startup Mahakumbh' is to be held from March 18-20, 2024 at Bharat Mandapam in Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, Delhi.
- ii. It is envisioned to make the Indian startup ecosystem stronger to have global dominance and foster entrepreneurship among Indian youth.
- iii. It aims to combine all stakeholders of the startup ecosystem to showcase entrepreneurship, technology, and innovation.
- iv. The **theme** of the Startup Mahakumbh is '**Bharat Innovates**,' which underscores the intricate link between innovation and startups.

MoE & MIB Jointly launches nationwide awareness campaign "Mera Pehla vote desh ke liye"

The Ministry of Education (**MoE**) and the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (**MIB**) have jointly launched a nationwide awareness campaign "**Mera pehla vote desh ke liye (my first vote for the country)**" to encourage the first-time voters to participate in the 2024 Lok Sabha election.

- Union Minister Anurag Thakur, MIB & Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (**MoYAS**) launched a Campaign Anthem video to create awareness among first-time voters.

About the Awareness Campaign:

- i. Under this Campaign, various events will be organised in universities, colleges, and higher education institutions.
- ii. The campaign activities involve both on-ground physical events and online competitions on the MyGov platform.
- iii. The activities such as competitions on blog writing, podcasts, debate, essay writing, quizzes, extempore, and battle of bands will be conducted to show student creativity in content creation.

iv. It also encourages to download the voter helpline app.

Key Facts about lok sabha:

i. The maximum sanctioned strength of the Lok Sabha (House of the People) by the constitution was 552 (530 representing states, 20 representing Union Territories (UT), and 2 representing the Anglo-Indian community).

- The two seats for Anglo-Indians were removed by the 104th Constitutional Amendment Act, 2019.

Note: The 17th Lok Sabha (the current LS) has 543 seats filled by elected representatives (530 from states & 13 from Union Territories (UTs)). The tenure of the current LS ends on 16th June 2024.

Anant Ambani launched 'Vantara' programme for Welfare of Animals

Anant Ambani, Director on the boards of Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) and Reliance Foundation, has launched an umbrella initiative called the 'Vantara' (Star of the Forests) programme to rescue, treat, care for, and rehabilitate injured, abused, and threatened animals, in India and abroad.

- The initiative is the **first of its kind** in India and it aims to construct the world's largest animal rescue and rehabilitation centre spanning about 3,000 acres within the Green Belt of Reliance's Jamnagar Refinery Complex in Gujarat.
- Vantara also aims to protect critically endangered species native to India, restore vital habitats, and address urgent threats to species survival.
- The initiative offers dedicated medical facilities and specialized animal kitchens.

"Status of Leopards in India": Number of leopards in India Increased by 8% from 2018 to 2022

According to the report "~~Status of Leopards in India~~" released by Union Minister Bhupender Yadav, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), estimated that the leopards population in India has risen by **8%** from 12,852 in 2018 to **13,874** in 2022.

- The fifth cycle leopard population estimation (2022) was carried out by the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) and Wildlife Institute of India (WII), in collaboration with State Forest Departments.
- The leopard population increased at an annual growth rate of 1.08% from 2018 to 2022.
- The report was part of the quadrennial (four-year) "Monitoring of Tiger, Co-predators, prey and their habitat" exercise in tiger range States.



- **Madhya Pradesh** has 3907 leopards, the highest number of leopards in India, followed by Maharashtra(1985) and Karnataka(1,879) in the second and third, respectively.
- Madhya Pradesh reported the most improvement in the number of leopards at 486 (3,421 in 2018 to 3,907 in 2022), while Odisha reported a drop of 192 (760 in 2018 to 568 in 2022).
- Tiger Reserves or sites having the highest leopard population are Nagarajunasagar Srisailem (Andhra Pradesh), followed by Panna (Madhya Pradesh), and Satpura (Madhya Pradesh).

PM Modi flagged off 'Swarna Sindhu' first tanker carrying Crude Oil from ONGC

Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi flagged off the first tanker 'Swarna Sindhu', carrying crude oil from Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC)'s **KG-DWN-98/2** deepwater project.

- The project is located in the Krishna Godavari basin and is expected to add 7% to India's oil and gas production at its peak.
- The Floating Production and Storage Offloading (FPSO) Armada Sterling V unit has been built and operated by Shapoorji Pallonji Energy Private Limited (SP Energy).
- The FPSO has a processing capacity of over 50,000 barrels of oil per day and 3 million standard cubic meters per day of gas.

PM Narendra Modi Inaugurates Bharat Tex 2024 in New Delhi

Prime Minister(PM) Narendra Modi inaugurated Bharat Tex 2024, the world's biggest textile event held from 26th to 29th February 2024 at the Bharat Mandapam, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi, Delhi.

- The event took place in 2 venues, the Bharat Mandapam and YashoBhoomi, two of India's largest exhibition centres.
- Bharat Tex 2024 inspired by PM Modi's 5F Vision(Farm to Fibre to Factory to Fashion to Foreign) was organised with a unified Farm to Fashion focus.

- Textiles Committee, Government e-Marketplace (GeM) and Standing Conference of Public Enterprises (SCOPE), signed MoU to promote upcycled Products Made From Scrap
- Indian Institute of Management(IIM), Jammu, Jammu and Kashmir(J&K) signed a MoU with the National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) Srinagar, J&K to foster entrepreneurship and innovation in the J&K.

VMC, Civic body of Gujarat, issues Asia's 1st Certified Green Municipal Bond

Vadodara Municipal Corporation (VMC), a civic body of Gujarat, has raised **Rs 100 crore** (USD 12.07 million) by issuing Asia's first certified green municipal bond for Sustainable Water Infrastructure.

- VMC, with a semi-annual coupon rate of 7.90% on the issue, invited bids from investors, setting a new standard in green finance.

Note:

- The bond was opened for bidding on the Electronic Bidding Platform (EBP) of BSE (Bombay Stock Exchange).
- This is the 2nd issue of bonds by Vadodara, after its first issue was oversubscribed by 10 times.

Key points:

- The funds generated will be dedicated to constructing and enhancing liquid wastewater management infrastructure throughout Vadodara, reflecting a commitment to sustainable urban development.
- The bonds are rated AA+ STABLE by India Ratings, and have received a green security certificate from the Climate Bond Initiative.
- Utilisation of proceeds for projects contributing to improved air and water quality through the collection, treatment, and reuse of sewage water.

PM Modi Virtually Inaugurated Priority Corridor of Agra Metro, the 6th Metro in UP

i. On 6th March 2024, during his visit to West Bengal, Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi virtually inaugurated the Agra Metro's priority corridor (from Taj East Gate to Mankameshwar) in Agra, Uttar Pradesh (UP).

- Yogi Adityanath, Chief Minister (CM) of UP, flagged off the Agra Metro from Taj Mahal Metro Station, Agra, UP. This is the 6th Metro project in UP.
- ii. The Agra Metro Rail Project backed by **EUR 450 million** loan from the European Investment Bank (EIB) covers the construction of 2 interconnected urban metro rail lines, spanning 30 kilometers long, and a network of 27 strategically located stations in Agra, UP.

Kerala Launches 'CSpace', India's 1st Government-Owned OTT Platform

On 7th March 2024, Kerala Chief Minister (CM) Pinarayi Vijayan has launched India's first government-owned OTT (over-the-top) platform, 'CSpace', at an event held at the Kairali Theatre in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala.

About CSpace:

CSpace is managed by Kerala State Film Development Corporation (KSFD), a state-owned company responsible for the promotion of the Malayalam cinema industry on behalf of the Department of Cultural Affairs, Government of Kerala.

Curator panel:

- The curator panel consists of 60 members from cultural background constituted by KSFD for selecting and approving the content.
- The list of curators includes Benyamin, OV Usha, Santhosh Sivan, Shyamaprasad, Sunny Joseph, and Jeo Baby.
- The three curators from the panel will evaluate every content that is submitted to the platform for its artistic, cultural, and infotainment merit.



iv. The content will be featured on the platform after the curator's recommendations.

Note: For the first phase of CSpace, the curators selected 42 films, including 35 feature films, six documentaries, and one short film.

MHA notified Citizenship Amendment Act Rules, 2024

On March 11, 2024, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) notified the rules under the Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 (CAA-2019). These rules, called the **Citizenship (Amendment) Rules, 2024** to fast-track the citizenship process for non-Muslims, immigrants such as Hindus, Sikhs, Jains, Buddhists, Parsis, and Christians from Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Afghanistan, who had entered India before December 31, 2014.



- The rules are notified over four years after Parliament passed this law on December 11, 2019 amending the Citizenship Act of 1955.
- These rules will enable the persons eligible under CAA-2019 to apply for grant of Indian citizenship.

Key Points:

i. The entire process for eligible people to submit applications for Indian citizenship under the law will be online.

ii. As per parliamentary procedures, legislation rules should be framed within six months of presidential assent. Failure to do so requires an extension from the Committees on Subordinate Legislation in both Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha.

- MHA obtained extensions from these committees at regular intervals to develop rules enabling eligible individuals to apply for Indian citizenship.

iii. **CAA doesn't apply to Indian citizens.** It's aimed at granting Indian citizenship to certain foreigners who faced religious persecution in neighboring countries due to their faith.

iv. The CAA doesn't apply to areas under the **Sixth Schedule of the Constitution** and those covered by the **Inner Line Permit system**, protecting the interests of tribal and indigenous communities in the North-Eastern region. Residents of these areas can't apply for Indian citizenship under the CAA.

Lakhpati Didi:

i. 'Lakhpati Didi' initiative is a skill development programme which was launched in 2023 and implemented by the MoRD.

ii. It helps rural females set up micro-enterprises in their respective villages and earn a sustainable income of at least Rs. 1 lakh annually per household by leveraging their entrepreneurial skills.

Aditya Birla Finance to be Amalgamated with Aditya Birla Capital

The Board of Directors (**BoD**) of Aditya Birla Capital Limited (**ABCL**) has approved the Scheme of Amalgamation of Aditya Birla Finance Limited (**ABFL**), with **ABCL**.

- The scheme aims to make **ABCL** a large unified operating Non-Banking Financial Company (**NBFC**).

Key Points:

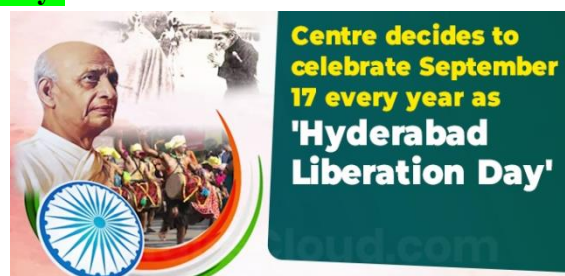
- i. The proposed amalgamation will result in a reduction of legal entities and simplification of the group structure of **ABCL**.
- ii. The proposed amalgamation will integrate the businesses and operational synergies and lead to the seamless implementation of policy changes and a reduction in the multiplicity of legal and regulatory compliances.
- iii. The amalgamation will also create a strong capital base for **ABCL** to grow its business.
- iv. The amalgamation is subject to the approval of the National Company Law Tribunal (**NCLT**), Reserve Bank of India (**RBI**), and Securities and Exchange Board of India (**SEBI**).

Post-merger leadership:

After the merger, **Vishakha Mulye** will be acting as Managing Director (**MD**) & Chief Executive Officer (**CEO**) whereas **Rakesh Singh** will assume the role as Executive Director (**ED**) and CEO (**NBFC**) of the merged amalgamated company.

GoI Designates September 17 as 'Hyderabad Liberation Day'

On 12th March 2024, the Ministry of Home Affairs (**MoHA**), Government of India (**GoI**), issued a gazette notification, officially designating **September 17** of every year as **Hyderabad Liberation Day**.



- The Day marks the integration of the erstwhile princely State of Hyderabad into the Indian Union in 1948.

Note: Hyderabad remained under the rule of Mir Osman Ali Khan, Nizam of Hyderabad, for 13 months post-independence on 15th August 1947.

Significance of September 17:

- i. Hyderabad was liberated from Nizam's Rule on 17th September 1948, after a police action namely '**Operation Polo**.'
- On 17th September 1948, Hyderabad Nizam announced a ceasefire and Major general (Maj Gen) Syed Ahmed El-Edroos, chief of the Hyderabad state forces, surrendered to Maj Gen Jayanto Nath Chaudhuri, who led the primary strike against Hyderabad state forces on 18th September 1948.
- ii. The day symbolises the end of Nizam's rule and the integration of Hyderabad into the Indian Union.
- iii. The Police Action was initiated by Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, who served as the 1st Deputy Prime Minister and 1st Home Minister of Independent India from 1947 to 1950.

GoI approved 'TG' Prefix on Vehicle Registration Plates in Telangana

On 12th March 2024, the Government of India (GoI) approved the 'TG' prefix on vehicle registration number plates in Telangana by replacing the 'TS' prefix.

- The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) also issued a gazette notification effective immediately.
- The approval was granted in the exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (6) of section 41 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988).
- The change will be applied to new vehicles and the vehicles with TS number plates will continue.
- The decision to replace the prefix code of vehicle registration from TS to TG was made by Chief Minister (CM) of Telangana, Anumula Revanth Reddy in his 1st cabinet meeting held in February 2024.

GoI Approves Transfer of Air India Building to Govt of Maharashtra for Rs 1,601 Crore

Government of India has approved the transfer of the Air India building at Nariman Point in Mumbai (Maharashtra) from AI Assets Holding Company Ltd (AIAHL) to the Government of Maharashtra (GoM) for a cash consideration of Rs 1,601 crore.

Centre approves transfer of Air India Bhawan to Maharashtra government for Rs 1,601 crore



- The Maharashtra govt has agreed to waive Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) dues amounting to Rs 298.42 crore. This would have been payable by AI Assets Holding Company Ltd to GoM.

Points to note:

- i. The Maharashtra Cabinet approved the acquisition of the 23-storey Air India building in November 2023.
- ii. The building was constructed in 1974 on the land owned by the GoM. The building was designed by renowned American architect John Burgee.
- iii. AIAHL is a state-owned entity overseeing Air India's debt and assets following its acquisition by the Tata Group in January 2022.
- iv. The acquisition offers GoM approximately 46,470 square meters of space near the state secretariat, established in 1955.

MIB Notifies Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 2024 to Improve Film Certification Process

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has notified the Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 2024 to improve the process of certification of films for public exhibition. This replaces the Cinematograph (Certification) Rules of 1983

- The rules were notified following the introduction of the Cinematograph (Amendment) Act, 2023, which amended the Cinematograph Act, 1952.

Note: The rules were notified in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Cinematograph Act, 1952 (37 of 1952).

About Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 2024:

- i.Aim:** To streamline and modernise the film certification process and to keep up with the new technologies and advancements in the film industry.
- ii.** The new rules were drafted by MIB and the Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) following extensive consultations with filmmakers, cinema owners, disability rights organisations, non-government organisations(NGOs), film industry bodies, the general public, and other stakeholders.
- iii.** The new rule was drafted in line with the adoption of an online certification process, which will ensure transparency, efficiency and ease of doing business for the film sector.

India, Brazil Hold First '2+2' Defence and Foreign Ministerial Dialogue

On 14th March 2024, India and Brazil held their first 2 plus 2 Secretary level Political and Military Dialogue in New Delhi, Delhi. The dialogue was co-chaired by,

- **India:** Godavarthi Venkata Srinivas, Additional Secretary (Latin American and Caribbean-LAC), Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) and Vishwesh Negi, Joint Secretary (International Cooperation), Ministry of Defence(MoD).
- **Brazil:** Marcelo Camara, Director, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA), and Rear Admiral Fernando de Luca Marques de Oliveira, MoD

Both countries discussed a variety of subjects, including defence, space, energy, critical minerals, technology, counter-terrorism, and regional, multilateral, and other issues of mutual interest.

Maharashtra CM Eknath Shinde Inaugurates India's First LNG-Powered Bus

Maharashtra Chief Minister(CM) Eknath Shinde has inaugurated India's first Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) powered bus, which will be operated by Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation(MSRTC).

- MSRTC announced that it will convert its 5,000 diesel vehicles into LNG alternative fuel vehicles in phases.
- MSRTC has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with M/s Kings Gas for the conversion of diesel buses to LNG. It includes the usage and supply of fuel.
- It will set up LNG distribution facilities at 90 depots across Maharashtra.

Six Madhya Pradesh Heritage Sites Included in UNESCO's Tentative List

Six heritage sites in Madhya Pradesh (MP) were included in the tentative list of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) World Heritage Sites (WHS).

- The six sites are Gwalior Fort, Khooni Bhandara, Bhojeshwar Mahadev Temple, the Rock art sites of Chambal Valley, the historic ensemble of Dhamnar, and the Gond monuments of Ramnagar.
- The Tentative list consists of sites that can be either cultural or natural areas or objects for having outstanding universal value.
- The heritage sites in the Tentative list will be considered for nominations to the UNESCO World Heritage List.
- As of 21st March 2024, India has 57 sites in UNESCO's Tentative list of heritage sites.

MeitY Notifies PIB's Fact Check Unit as Authorised Body for Centre under IT Rules 2021

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (**MeitY**) notified the Fact Check Unit (**FCU**) under the Press Information Bureau (**PIB**) as a statutory body with powers to flag misinformation about the Central government and its departments across social media platforms.

- FCU under the PIB of the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB) has been designated as the FCU of the government of India.
- This was notified in exercise of power conferred by Rule 3(1)(b)(v) of the Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021 (IT Rules 2021).

Points to note:

i. The rule mandates all social media and internet intermediaries' to make reasonable efforts to prevent the spread of deceptive or misleading content from their users, related to the central government.

ii. It is stated that the social media platforms could lose legal immunity for user-generated content if they choose to keep notified misinformation online.

Note: Not just social media companies, but even internet and telecom service providers will have to block that information, meaning that a web link of a particular report could potentially be blocked.

Categories: The PIB FCU classifies any received information into 3 categories: Fake, Misleading, and True.

Operational Structure:

i. FCU is managed by 3 Joint Director rank officers of the Indian Information Service, overseen by the Principal Director General (DG) of the PIB.

ii. Principal DG of PIB functions as the Principal Spokesperson of the Government of India (GoI).

Recent Amendments:

i. In April 2023, MeitY amended the IT Rules 2021 to introduce the provisions for a government-run FCU to verify any information about the central government.

ii. The amendments included a provision for an FCU by the government to identify "fake or false or misleading" online content related to the "business" of the central government.

About PIB's FCU:

i. The FCU under PIB was founded in November 2019 to deter the spread of fake news and

misinformation.

ii. Its primary goal is to counter misinformation regarding government policies, initiatives, and schemes.

iii. Alternative text (ALT) is provided by PIB's FCU alongside social media posts to ensure accessibility for persons with disabilities (PWDs).

IAU Approves to Name Chandrayaan-3's Landing Site as 'Statio Shiv Shakti'

International Astronomical Union (IAU)'s Working Group for Planetary System Nomenclature (WGPSN) has approved the name "Statio Shiv Shakti" for the landing site of Chandrayaan-3's Vikram lander.



- The approval was given on **19th March 2024**.
- The term Shiv Shakti is derived from Indian mythology describing the masculine ("Shiva") and feminine ("Shakti") duality of nature.

Note: The WGPSN of IAU is responsible for formulating and coordinating all topographic nomenclature on the planetary bodies of the solar system.

Background:

i. On 23rd August 2023, the Vikram lander of Chandrayaan-3, the 3rd mission in the Chandrayaan programme, successfully soft landed near the moon's south pole.

ii. Narendra Modi, Prime Minister (PM) of India announced that the landing site will be named "Shiv Shakti" and the 23rd August of every year will be observed as National Space Day in India.

Additional info: The crash site of Chandrayaan-2 on the lunar surface was named 'Tiranga Point'.

Tejas Mark-1A fighter aircraft completes first flight in Bengaluru

On March 28, 2024, the Tejas Mark (Mk)-1A fighter aircraft made its successful maiden flight from the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) facility in Bengaluru, Karnataka.

- HAL's chief test pilot, Group **Captain KK Venugopal** (retd) flew the light combat aircraft (LCA) Mk-1A.

About Tejas Mark-1A:

i. Tejas Mark-1A fighter features advanced radar, electronic warfare, and improved combat capabilities.

- The Tejas Mark-1A is designed by the Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) under the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and manufactured by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL).

ii. Major upgrades include an active electronic scanned array (AESA) radar, a combined interrogator and transponder (CIT) and a digital map generator.

- The digital map generator, designed and developed by HAL's Mission and Combat Systems Research and Development Centre (MCSR&DC), had thermal issues and was a failure point in the Tejas Mark 1. This has been replaced with computers designed by MCSR&DC.

iii. HAL has integrated the ASRAAM (advanced short range air-to-air missile) for the Mark 1A's outboard stations.

iv. Cockpit floor modification allows 95% of IAF pilots (even the bigger pilots), including with shoe size 10, to fly comfortably.

Note:

IAF ordered 83 Mk-1A fighters for Rs. 48,000 crore in February 2021 and planned to buy 97 more Mk-1A's at a cost of around Rs. 67,000 crore.

US Chamber's International IP Index 2024: India retained 42nd rank; The USA tops

According to the 12th edition of the International Intellectual Property (IP) Index (2024) by the United States (US) Chamber of Commerce, **India** has retained the **42nd rank** with an overall score of 38.64%.

- The United States of America (**USA**) has topped the list with an overall score of 95.48% followed by the United Kingdom (**UK**) in the 2nd place with 94.12% and **France** in the 3rd with 93.12%.

About International IP Index:

i. It provides a blueprint for economies aiming to bolster innovation and creativity through robust intellectual property (IP) standards.

ii. The Index assesses IP frameworks of 55 economies using 50 unique criteria related to patents, copyrights, enforcement, and more.

Note: Previously, India was ranked 42nd in 2023 and 43rd in 2022.

India's IP Strengths:

i. The report highlights India's commendable efforts, citing the Cinematograph (Amendment) Bill 2023, which includes new language and criminal sanctions on film piracy.

ii. Strong initiatives include dynamic injunction orders against copyright piracy, incentives for Research and Development (R&D), and IP-based tax.

Challenges and Weaknesses of India's IP:

i. The report expresses concerns about India's IP regime, emphasising issues such as the dissolution of the Intellectual Property Appellate Board in 2021.

ii. India faces challenges with an under-resourced judiciary, impacting rights holders' ability to enforce IP rights and resolve IP-related disputes.

PM Modi & Mauritian PM Pravind Jugnauth jointly Inaugurate New Airstrip & a Jetty at Agaléga Island in Mauritius

On February 29, 2024, the Prime Minister (PM) of India, Narendra Modi and PM of Mauritius, Pravind Jugnauth, jointly inaugurated an **Airstrip** and a **Saint James Jetty** at the **Agaléga** Island in Mauritius via video conferencing.

- They also inaugurated the six community development projects in Agaléga that were implemented with financial assistance from India.

Points to note:

- i. These inaugurations will fulfil the demand for better connectivity between mainland Mauritius and Agaléga, **strengthen maritime security** and foster socio-economic development.
- ii. This will also expand India's strategic outreach in the Southern Indian Ocean region (IOR).
- iii. Jetty will facilitate operation of India's **Boeing P-8I** maritime surveillance planes for anti-submarine and anti-surface warfare, bolstering India's security role in IOR.
- iv. Both nations cooperate in Exclusive Economic Zones (EEZ) monitoring, joint patrolling, and hydrography.

Additional info:

- i. Inauguration of projects follows the launch of India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI) systems and RuPay card services in Mauritius.
- ii. **PM Modi noted that** Mauritius will be the **1st nation** to join India's Jan Aushadi Scheme for affordable medicines. This allows the sourcing of about 250 high-quality medicines from the Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices Bureau of India, and establishment of Jan Ayushadhi Kendras in Mauritius.
- iii. Over the past 10 years, India extends USD 1 billion credit line and USD 400 million assistance to Mauritius.

Comoros, Timor-Leste Becomes New Members of WTO at MC13 held in Abu Dhabi

On 26th February 2024, The **Union of the Comoros** and the **Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste** have formally become the members of the World Trade Organisation (WTO). The signing ceremony was held during the WTO's 13th Ministerial Conference (**MC13**) hosted by the United Arab Emirates (UAE) in Abu Dhabi.

- With the accession of Comoros and Timor-Leste, the total number of **WTO members** becomes **166**.
- The MC13 was held from 26th to 29th February 2024 and the conference was chaired by H.E. Dr Thani bin Ahmed Al Zeyoudi, UAE's Minister of State for Foreign Trade.

Key points:

- i. WTO implemented an agreement on new disciplines on domestic services regulations benefiting all members, including non-signatories like India.
- ii. It was signed by 72 members, including the United States of America (USA), 28 members of the European Union (EU), China, and Japan.

For the first time, WBL assesses the gap between legal reforms and actual outcomes for women in 190 economies.



- The index shows that in India, women enjoy 60% of the legal rights granted to men, which is lower than the global average of 64.2%.
- Despite challenges, India outperforms its South Asian counterparts, where women enjoy 45.9% of the legal protections provided to men.

- The book also speaks about foreign intervention in manipulating Sri Lankan politics and weakening the economy since the end of the war against the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE) in 2009
- The book is available in the **English** and **Sinhalese** language.

Sweden Officially Joins NATO as it's 32nd Member

On March 7, 2024, **Sweden** officially joined the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO), becoming the alliance's 32nd member. With this, Sweden ends decades of post-World War II neutrality and 200 years of non-alignment with major powers.

Note: This decision comes in the wake of security concerns in Europe following Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February 2022.

Key Points:

- i. Sweden now benefits from the protection provided under Article 5 of the NATO Treaty, which guarantees the freedom and security of its allies.
- ii. Swedish accession strengthens the NATO's defence on the northern flank.

NATO is an intergovernmental military alliance of countries from Europe and North America. Objective- To safeguard the freedom and security of its members through both political and military means.

Panama becomes 97th member to ratify the International Solar Alliance

Panama joined the International Solar Alliance (ISA) as its 97th member, showing its commitment to advancing solar energy in the energy sector.



- In this regard, Panama's Ambassador to India **Yasiel Burillo** handed over the Instrument of Ratification to Joint Secretary (Economic Diplomacy) **Abhishek Singh**, Ministry of External affairs (MEA) during the meeting in New Delhi, Delhi.
- This move aligns with the efforts of other nations in harnessing solar energy for a sustainable future.
- Notably, on March 5th, Malta became the 119th Signatory country to join the ISA.

The ISA was established in Paris, France in 2015 as a joint effort by India and France to mobilize efforts against climate change through the deployment of solar energy solutions. It was conceptualized on the sidelines of the 21st Conference of Parties (COP21) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) held in Paris in 2015.

SIPRI Report 2023: India World's Largest Arms Importer Between 2019– 2023

According to 'Trends in International Arms Transfers, 2023' released by Swedish think tank, Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), India was the world's top arms importer for the period 2019-23. India's imports has increased by 4.7% compared to the period 2014-18.



- Saudi Arabia and Qatar were the 2nd and 3rd largest importers.

- United States (US), France, Russia were the **top 3 largest exporters** of arms between 2019-23.

India's main suppliers:

- i.Russia** remains India's top arms supplier at **36%**, however, it's the first time since 1960–64 that their deliveries comprised less than half of India's imports.
- ii.**The 2nd and 3rd main suppliers of India are **France (33%)** and the United States of America(**USA**) (**13%**).

iii.On 23rd March 2024, PM Modi and Tshering Tobgay, PM of Bhutan, inaugurated the **Gyaltsuen Jetsun Pema Wangchuck Mother and Child Hospital** in Thimphu, Bhutan.

United Nations adopts 1st Global Resolution on Artificial Intelligence

On 21st March 2024, The United Nations General Assembly(**UNGA**) unanimously adopted the 1st global resolution on Artificial Intelligence (AI) which encourages nations to safeguard human rights, protect personal data, and monitor AI for risks.

- The nonbinding resolution was proposed by the United States of America(**USA**) and was co-sponsored by 123 countries, including China, Cuba, and Russia.

Note: The draft resolution was adopted without a vote highlighting the respect, protection and promotion of human rights in the design, development, and use of AI.

Key Points:

- i.**This is the first time the UNGA has adopted a resolution on regulating an emerging field.
- ii.**The primary objective of the resolution is to use AI which can help in achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by 2030 such as:

- Ending Global Hunger and Poverty
- Improving health worldwide
- Ensuring Quality Secondary Education for All Children

- Achieving Gender Equality.

Significance:

- i. It aims to remove the digital divide between rich developed countries and poor developing countries.
- ii. The resolution ensures that developing countries will have access to technology and capabilities to take benefits from AI such as: detecting diseases, predicting floods and provide training to the next generation of workers.

2024 Hurun Global Rich List: Mukesh Ambani becomes world's 10th Richest man; Mumbai Becomes Asia's Billionaire Capital

According to the "2024 Hurun Global Rich List", **Mukesh Ambani**, Chairman & Managing Director(CMD) of Reliance Industries Limited(RIL), has been ranked as the **World's 10th richest Person** with a total net worth of USD 115 billion.



- **Elon Musk**, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Tesla Motors, **topped** the list for the 3rd time, with a total net worth of USD 231 billion followed by **Jeff Bezos**, founder of Amazon (USD 185 billion) and **Bernard Arnault**, CEO of LVMH Moët Hennessy Louis Vuitton (175 billion).
- **Mumbai**(Maharashtra), overtakes Beijing(China) to become the **billionaire capital of Asia**. 92 billionaires of India are based in Mumbai while Beijing houses 91 billionaires.

- iii. Sea phase focuses on joint skill development and diverse operations.

About INS Kiltan:

- i. INS Kiltan, launched in March 2013, was handed over to the Indian Navy in 2017 by Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers Limited (**GRSE**).
- ii. It is propelled by a Combination of Diesel and Diesel (**CODAD**) system, achieving speeds over 25 knots and a range of 3,500 nautical miles.
- iii. It is the first major warship with entirely composite material superstructure.

Indian Navy Commissions INS Jatayu at Minicoy & India's 1st MH-60R Seahawk Helicopter Squadron in Kochi

The Indian Navy (IN) commissioned the Indian Naval Ship (INS) Jatayu at Minicoy, the southernmost island in Lakshadweep. This is the 2nd naval base in Lakshadweep after INS Dweepprakash in Kavaratti, the capital of Lakshadweep.

- It was commissioned by Admiral Radhakrishnan (R.) Hari Kumar, the Chief of Naval Staff (CNS).

The CNS R. Hari Kumar also commissioned **Indian Naval Air Squadron (INAS) 334 'Seahawks'**, India's first MH 60R multirole helicopter squadron, at INS Garuda in Kochi, Kerala.



- The first Seahawk squadron of 48 officers and 170 men is commanded by Captain M. Abhishek Ram. The squadron is raised with six helicopters.

Sea Defenders-2024; India-USA Maritime Security Exercise held at Port Blair

‘Sea Defenders-2024’, the comprehensive maritime security exercise between the Indian Coast Guard (ICG) & United States Coast Guard (USCG) was successfully concluded at Port Blair, Andaman & Nicobar (A&N) Island on 9th March 2024.

Aim of the Exercise: To enhance maritime cooperation and interoperability between ICG & USCG.

Key Points:

- i. ‘Sea Defenders-2024 exercise covered various situations like pollution response, showcasing firefighting and damage control skills, practice to neutralize asymmetric threats related to drone threats and shipboard emergencies.
- ii. The exercise also witnessed Visit Board Search and Seizure (VBSS) Operations for inspecting vessels suspected of illegal activity and medical evacuation exercises to enhance readiness in emergency situations.
- iii. The joint exercise allowed both ICG & USCG to refine their skills and improve their ability to work together in a coordinated manner.

USCG Ship Bertholf:

- i. USCGC Bertholf, a Legend-class maritime security cutter, participated in the exercise by engaging in harbour activities, sea exercises and cross-visits
- ii. Bertholf is equipped with advanced technology and weaponry such as a helicopter landing pad, state-of-the-art sensors and communication equipment.



Defence Minister Rajnath Singh inaugurated ‘Nausena Bhawan’ the new Headquarters of Indian Navy

On 15th March 2024, Union Minister Rajnath Singh, Ministry of Defence (MoD), has inaugurated ‘Nausena Bhawan’, the first independent headquarters building of the Indian Navy (IN), at Delhi Cantonment in New Delhi, Delhi.

Key People:

The event was attended by General Anil Chauhan, Chief of Defence Staff (CDS); Admiral Radhakrishnan Hari Kumar, Chief of the Naval Staff (CNS).

About Nausena Bhawan:

- i. Nausena Bhawan has three wings across four stories. The complex is equipped with a state-of-the-art integrated building management system and has achieved **Green Rating IV** under the integrated habitability assessment.
- ii. Through an all-India competition, Nausena Bhawan’s architectural design was chosen.

Integrated Tri-Service Firepower and Manoeuvre Exercise ‘Bharat Shakti’ held in Rajasthan

A 50-minute-long synergised demonstration of indigenous defence capabilities in the form of a Tri-Services Live Fire and Manoeuvre Exercise ‘Bharat Shakti’ was held at Pokhran during PM Modi’s visit to Rajasthan on 12th March 2024.

ii. Delegates from around 30 nations were present at the event.

i. 'Bharat Shakti' exercise displayed an array of indigenous weapon systems and platforms to showcase India's unprecedented excellence in global military equipment production.

ii. The exercise demonstrated the firepower capabilities of indigenous weapons and the operational readiness of all three defence forces namely Indian Army (IA), Indian Navy (IN) and Indian Air Force (IAF).

iii. The exercise also simulated realistic, synergised, multi-domain operations displaying integrated operational capabilities of the Indian Armed Forces to counter threats across land, air, sea, cyber, and space domains.

Showcased weapons:

IA:

IA was represented by T-90 (IM) Tanks, Main Battle Tank Arjun, K-9 Vajra, Dhanush (howitzer) and Sarang Gun Systems, Akash Weapons System, Logistics Drones, Robotic Mules, Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) and an array of unmanned aerial vehicles along with Pinaka rocket system.

IN:

IN showcased Naval Anti-Ship Missiles, Autonomous Cargo Carrying Aerial Vehicles, and Expendable Aerial Target to highlight maritime strength and technological sophistication.

IAF:

Indian Air Force showcased the indigenously developed Light Combat Aircraft (LCA) Tejas, Light Utility Helicopters, Advanced Light Helicopters (ALH) Mk-IV Dhruv and Prachand helicopters. demonstrating air superiority and versatility in air operations.

Exercise Tiger Triumph – 24: 3rd Edition of India & USA Tri-Service HADR Exercise Commenced in AP

"Exercise Tiger Triumph – 24", the 3rd edition of the Bilateral Tri-Service Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) Amphibious Exercise between India and the United States of America (USA) was commenced on 18th March 2024 in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh (AP).

Aim: To share best practices and Standard Operating Procedures in undertaking multinational HADR operations and refine Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) to enable rapid and smooth coordination between forces of both countries.

Participating Units:

i. **Indian Navy (IN):** IN is represented by a Landing Platform Dock, Landing Ship Tanks including Landing Crafts and helicopters, guided missile Frigate and Long Range Maritime Reconnaissance Aircraft.

ii. **Indian Army (IA):** The participating units from IA include one infantry battalion group including mechanised forces.

iii. **Indian Air Force (IAF):** IAF will be represented by medium lift aircraft, transport helicopters and a Rapid Action Medical Team (RAMT).

Note: Special Operations Forces (SOF) from all three services will also participate in the exercise.

iv. **USA Navy:** The US Task Force would deploy USA Navy Landing Platform Dock including its integral Landing Craft Air Cushions and helicopters, a Destroyer, maritime reconnaissance and medium lift aircraft, along with US Marines Corps and US Army.

Phases:

Harbour Phase:

- i. The Harbour Phase of the exercise is being conducted at Visakhapatnam from 18th March to 25th March 2024.
- ii. Activities such as pre-sail discussions, Subject Matter Expert Exchange, and deliberations on planning and execution procedures of various tasks will be carried out during this phase.

Sea phase:

- i. The Sea Phase of the exercise will be conducted from 26th March to 31st March 2024. The troops will undertake Maritime, Amphibious and HADR operations.
- ii. In this phase, a joint Command and Control Centre and a Joint Relief and Medical Camp will be conducted by the units of India and the USA.

Key Points:

- i. On 19th March 2024, the exercise was held onboard the Indian Naval Ship (INS) **Jalashwa**.
- ii. A Planning and Coordination Exercise will also be conducted parallel to Exercise Tiger Triumph – 24 to discuss and refine Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).
- iii. The first Tiger Triumph exercise was held in 2019 in Visakhapatnam.

‘Operation Indravati’ Launched to Evacuate Stranded Indians in Haiti

The Government of India (GoI) launched ‘**Operation Indravati**’ to evacuate stranded Indians in **Haiti** after armed gangs seized control of most of the Caribbean nation.

- On 21st March 2024, Union Minister Subrahmanyam (S.) Jaishankar, Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), announced that the twelve Indians were evacuated through Operation Indravati.
- Acting President and Prime Minister Ariel Henry of Haiti resigned on 12th March 2024, due to the ongoing crisis.

About Haiti:

Haiti, Located between the Caribbean Sea and the North Atlantic Ocean, borders the Dominican Republic on the eastern side of the island. Its closest neighbors include Jamaica to the west and Cuba to the northwest.

Appointments or Resign/Retired

President Appoints New Chairman & Members of Lokpal; Justice AM Khanwilkar as Chairman

On 27th February 2024, Droupadi Murmu, President of India, has appointed the new Chairman and Members of Lokpal, the anti-corruption authority in India. Former Supreme Court judge **Ajay Manikrao Khanwilkar** was appointed as the chairperson of Lokpal.

- He will be the second regular chairperson of the Lokpal.

Note:

- The Lokpal has been working without its regular chairperson since the retirement of Justice Pinaki Chandra Ghose, 1st Chairperson of Lokpal, on 27th May 2022.
- Justice Pradip Kumar Mohanty, a judicial member of the Lokpal, has been serving as the acting chairperson of Lokpal since 28th May 2022.

About Justice A M Khanwilkar:

- i. Justice A. M. Khanwilkar was born on 30th July 1957, in Pune, Maharashtra.
- ii. He was appointed as Additional Judge of the Bombay High Court in March 2000 and confirmed as permanent Judge in April 2002.
- iii. He served as the CJ of the Himachal Pradesh HC from April to November 2013 and as CJ of the Madhya Pradesh HC from November 2013 to May 2016.
- iv. Khanwilkar served as a judge of the Supreme Court from May 2016 to July 2022.

New Members of Lokpal:

President Droupadi Murmu has appointed six members to Lokpal including three judicial and three non-judicial.

Judicial Members:

- i. Justice **Lingappa Narayana Swamy**, former Chief Justice of the Himachal Pradesh High Court
- ii. Justice **Ritu Raj Awasthi**, former chief justice of the Karnataka High Court.
- iii. Justice **Sanjay Yadav**, former chief justice of Allahabad High Court.

Non-Judicial Members:

- i. Sushil Chandra, former Chief Election Commissioner.
- ii. Pankaj Kumar, former Gujarat chief secretary.
- iii. Ajay Tirkey, former secretary of the Department of Land Resources (DoLR), Government of India.

Note:

- i. As of 29th Feb'24, Ritu Raj Awasthi is serving as the chairperson of the law commission, and he will resign from that post before taking over as a member of Lokpal.
- ii. The above appointments will take effect on the dates they assume charge of their respective offices.

About the Lokpal:

- i. The Lokpal inquires and investigates the allegations of corruption against public functionaries.
- ii. It is the first institution of its kind in independent India, established under the Lokpal and Lokayuktas Act 2013.
- iii. It consists of a chairperson and **8 members**, of whom 50% are judicial members.

iv. Term of office: The chairperson and other members hold office for a term of **5 years** from the date on which they enter upon the office or until they attain the age of **70 years**, whichever is earlier.

v. Jurisdiction: It can inquire into allegations of corruption against anyone who is or has been Prime Minister, or a Minister in the Union government, or a Member of Parliament, as well as officials of the Union Government under Groups A, B, C and D.

Mian Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif Took Oath as Pakistan's PM for a 2nd Time

Mian Muhammad Shehbaz Sharif was sworn in as the Prime Minister (PM) of **Pakistan** for a **2nd term** on 4 March 2024. Pakistan's newly formed parliament elected Shehbaz Sharif as the new PM, who secured 201 votes in a 336-member National Assembly, surpassing the required 169 votes.

- Previously, he served as PM of a coalition government for 16 months from April 2022 to August 2023 before Parliament was dissolved to hold general elections.
- President Arif Alvi administered the oath to him at a ceremony at the Presidential mansion, Aiwan-e-Sadr in Islamabad, Pakistan.

Note:

- On 14 August 2023, Anwar-ul-Haq Kakar was appointed as Pakistan's 8th caretaker PM.
- Shehbaz Sharif is the younger brother of 3-time PM of Pakistan, Nawaz Sharif, who currently serves as the President of the Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) party.

Election Outcome:

i. Pakistan held general elections to its National Assembly – the lower house on 8 February 2024.

ii. Shehbaz Sharif was the consensus candidate of the PML-N party and Bilawal Bhutto Zardari's Pakistan Peoples Party (PPP).

iii. Shehbaz Sharif defeated his opponent, Omar Ayub Khan of the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party of jailed former PM Imran Khan, which secured 92 votes.

iv. Both PML-N (75 seats) and PPP (54 seats) formed a coalition government, with one of the PTI-backed legislators also joining the PML-N's party.

Note: As per Pakistan's constituency, a political party or alliance needs 169 seats in the National Assembly to assume power.

About Mian Muhammad Shahbaz Sharif:

i. His career in public service began as President of the Lahore Chamber of Commerce & Industry in 1985.

ii. He was elected to the Punjab Assembly in 1988 and to Pakistan's National Assembly (1990-93) and later to the Punjab Assembly (1993-96) as Leader of the Opposition.

iii. He became a Member of the Punjab Assembly for the 3rd time in 1997.

iv. He was elected as Chief Minister (CM) of Punjab and was sent into forced exile after the 1999 military coup.

v. He was elected unopposed as a Member Punjab Assembly for the 4th term in 2008, serving as CM for the 2nd time till 2013.

vi. In 2018, he was elected as a member of the National Assembly and served as the opposition leader until Imran Khan's removal via a no-trust vote in April 2022.

Brajesh Mehrotra appointed as Chief Secretary of Bihar

The Government of Bihar has appointed **Brajesh Mehrotra**, a 1989 batch Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer, as the Chief Secretary (CS) of Bihar with effect from **4th March 2024**.

- Mehrotra succeeded **Amir Subhani**, a 1987 batch IAS officer, who voluntarily retired from the post.
- Prior to the appointment, Mehrotra served as additional chief secretary of revenue and land reforms with the additional charge of general administration and parliamentary affairs. He also holds the post of Bihar's chief information commissioner.

Note: Amir Subhani was given charge of Chairman of Bihar Electricity Regulatory Commission (BERC) for five years from the date of assuming charge, or till the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier.

Gustavo Adrianzen Becomes New PM of Peru

Gustavo Lino Adrianzen Olaya was sworn in as Prime Minister (PM) or President of the Council of Ministers (PCM) of the Republic of Peru with effect from 6th March 2024.

- The swearing-in ceremony was led by the President of Peru, **Dina Boluarte** at the Government Palace in Lima, Peru.
- Gustavo Adrianzen succeeded **Alberto Otarola** who resigned from the post on 05th March 2024 due to a political scandal.
- Prior to the appointment, Adrianzen had been the Permanent Representative of Peru to the Organization of American States (OAS), based in the United States of America (USA), since February 2023.

Famous Indian Author, philanthropist & Padma Awardee Sudha Murty Nominated to Rajya Sabha by President

The President of India, **Droupadi Murmu** has nominated renowned author, Indian philanthropist & Padma Awardee **Sudha Murty** as the 12th nominated Member of Parliament (MP) in the Upper House of Parliament (Rajya Sabha (RS)).

About Sudha Murty:

i. Sudha Murty, a former Infosys Foundation chairperson, is the wife of N. R. Narayana Murthy who is the co-founder of Infosys.

ii. She is an active member of public health care initiatives of the Gates Foundation and she is known for her philanthropy activity.

iii. She received several awards including **Padma Shri** (the 4th highest civilian award) in 2006 and **Padma Bhushan** (the third highest civilian award) in 2023 for Social Work.

Note: Under Article 80 (3) of the Constitution of India, out of the 250 members in the RS, 12 are nominated by the President, on the recommendation of the government of India, and 238 members represents the States and Union Territories.

Asif Ali Zardari Sworn in as Pakistan's 14th President for 2nd Term

On 10 March 2024, **Asif Ali Zardari**, co-chairman of the center-left Pakistan People's Party (PPP) was sworn in as the **14th President** of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan for the **2nd time**. Previously, he served as the 11th President of Pakistan from 9th September 2008 to 9th September 2013.

- Asif Ali Zardari replaced Arif Alvi, who stayed in office for 5 months after completing his 5-year term in September 2023.
- Chief Justice of Pakistan Qazi Faez Isa administered the oath to Asif Ali Zardari at Aiwan-e-Sadr, the Presidential Palace in Islamabad, Pakistan.

Election Results:

i.Asif Ali Zardari secured 411 electoral votes in parliament and all 4 provincial assemblies, backed by PPP, Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) party, and the Muttahida Qaumi Movement-Pakistan (MQM-P).

iii.Opposition candidate Mahmood Khan Achakzai, supported by Pakistan-Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI), and Sunni Ittehad Council (SIC), secured 181 votes.

About Asif Ali Zardari:

i.His first government role was as the environment minister during Benazir's second term (1993-1996) and also as the minister of investment from 1995 to 1996.

ii.He has been elected as a member of the National Assembly 4 times and as a senator from 1990 to 2024.

- He resigned from parliament after being elected as president in March 2024.
- iii.He was elected president in 2008, the 1st ever democratically elected president to complete his full term in Pakistan's history.

Nayab Singh Saini Sworn in as 11th CM of Haryana

On 12th March 2024, **Nayab Singh Saini**, Haryana State President of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and a Member of Parliament (MP) elected from the Kurukshetra Constituency, was sworn in as the **11th Chief Minister (CM)** of Haryana.



- Haryana Governor **Bandaru Dattatreya** administered oath of office and secrecy to Nayab Singh Saini in the event held in Chandigarh.
- Nayab Singh Saini succeeded **Manohar Lal Khattar** who stepped down resulting in a split in BJP-Jannayak Janata Party (BJP-JJP) alliance which had ruled the state since 2019.

About Nayab Singh Saini:

i.Nayab Saini started his political career in 1996 by joining BJP.

ii.In 2014, he became an MLA for the first time representing Narayangarh Constituency.

iii.He served as a Minister of State for Labour and Employment and Mines & Geology in the Manohar Lal Khattar cabinet from 2014 to 2019.

iv.Since 2019, he has been serving as an MP in the Lower House of Parliament (Lok Sabha(LS)).

Additional Info:

The BJP has 41 MLAs in the 90-member House, while the JJP has 10. The main opposition Indian National Congress (INC) has 30 MLAs while the Indian National Lok Dal and Haryana Lokhit Party one seat each.

Devendra Jhajharia Elected as President Of Paralympic Committee Of India

Javelin thrower Devendra Jhajharia was elected unopposed as the president of the Paralympic Committee of India (PCI). He succeeded para-athlete Deepa Malik as president of PCI, whose term ended on 31st January 2024.

- Devendra Jhajharia won two gold medals and a silver in the Paralympics. He won a gold medal in the 2004 Athens(Greece) and the 2016 Rio de Janeiro(Brazil) Paralympics in the F46 disability category. He won a silver medal in the 2020 Tokyo(Japan) Paralympics.
- Jhajharia has received awards including the Khel Ratna (2017), Arjuna Award (2004), Padma Shri (2012), and Padma Bhushan (2022) in the field of sports. He was the **only para-athlete** to win the **Padma Bhushan** award so far.
- The other office-bearers who were elected along with the President were R. Chandrashekhar and Satya Prakash Sangwan as Vice Presidents, Jayawant Hammanawar as Secretary General.

Gyanesh Kumar & Dr. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu appointed as new Election Commissioners; Arun Goel Resigns

On 15th March 2024, Retired Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers **Gyanesh Kumar** and **Dr. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu** took charge as the New Election Commissioners(ECs) in the Election Commission of India(ECI).



- Gyanesh Kumar and Dr. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu are of 1988 batch from Kerala & Uttarakhand cadre respectively.
- The post of ECs were vacant since the retirement of Anup Chandra Pandey on 14th February 2024 and resignation of Arun Goel on 8th March 2024.

Note: The appointment was made by a high-powered selection committee chaired by Prime Minister(PM) Narendra Modi. The committee includes Union Minister Arjun Meghwal, Ministry of Law and Justice and Leader of Opposition Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury.

Details of the appointment:

- This appointment marks the inaugural instance of Election Commissioners being appointed under the new Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) and other ECs (Appointment, Conditions of Service and Term of Office) Act, 2023 brought in by the government in December 2023.
- Sukhbir Singh Sandhu was appointed as EC on 3rd February 2024 for a contract term of one year. His tenure will end on 4th February 2025.

About Gyanesh Kumar:

i. Prior to his retirement in January 2024, he served as Secretary of the Ministry of Cooperation. He has also served as Additional Secretary in the Ministry of Home Affairs (MoHA) and secretary in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.

About Sukhbir Singh Sandhu:

i. He served as the Chairman of the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) and also as Additional Secretary of the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development.

iii. He was appointed as the Chief Secretary of Uttarakhand in 2021. He retired from the post in January 2024.

Arun Goel resigned from the post of EC:

i. Election Commissioner Arun Goel resigned from his post as EC ahead of 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

ii. He was appointed as EC on 19th November 2022 and his tenure as EC was till 6th December 2027.

ECI named Sheetal Devi as National Icon in PwD category

The Election Commission of India (ECI) has chosen **Sheetal Devi**, an Indian para-archer and 2023 Arjuna Awardee, as the National Icon in Persons with Disabilities (PwD) category.

- The announcement was made at an Exhibition Cricket which was organised by ECI in association with the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) in New Delhi, Delhi.
- The event was attended by Rajiv Kumar, Chief Election Commissioner (CEC); Gyanesh Kumar, Election Commissioner and Sukhbir Singh Sandhu, Election Commissioner.
- On the occasion, ECI launched a dedicated Voter's Guide for PwDs and Senior Citizen Electors.

Kishor Makwana Assumes Charge as Chairman of National Commission for Scheduled Castes

Kishor Makwana assumed the charge of **Chairman** of the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC) in New Delhi, Delhi. Luv Kush Kumar and Vaddepalli Ramchander also assumed charge as members of the NCSC.

The post of NCSC Chairman was vacant after Vijay Sampla resigned on 18th July 2023

- Arun Halder was vice chairman during the resignation and he later assumed charge as acting chairman and held the position till February 18 2024.
- The tenure of the Commission is three years and this is the 7th Commission.
- Kishor Makwana, a journalist and columnist, has authored more than 33 books, including 'Samajik Kranti na Mahanayak Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar' (great hero of the social revolution – Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar), his notable works include 'Common Man Narendra Modi'.

- The NCSC is a constitutional body set up under **Article 338** of the Constitution of India.

Vladimir Putin won 5th term as the President of Russia

Russian President Vladimir Putin (71 years old) has secured a record **fifth term** as President of Russia by winning the 2024 Presidential elections. He secured around 88% (87.97%) of the total votes.

- He is scheduled to be inaugurated on 7th May 2024.
- With this new 6-year term, Putin becomes the longest-serving Russian or Soviet leader in history since Joseph Stalin and the longest-reigning president in post-Soviet Russia.

Note: Joseph Stalin served as leader of the Soviet Union from 1924 until his death in 1953.

About Vladimir Putin:

- i. Vladimir Putin was born in Leningrad on October 7, 1952.
- ii. He served as Prime Minister (PM) of Russia in 1999 under the Premiership of Boris Yeltsin.
- iii. In December 1999, he became the acting President of Russia after Yeltsin resigned.
- iv. He served as President of Russia from 2000 to 2004, 2004-2008, 2012 to 2018, and 2018 to 2024.
- v. He also served as the PM of Russia from 2008 to 2012.

Awards and honours:

- i. Time magazine named Vladimir Putin as TIME's Person of the Year in 2007.
- ii. The China International Peace Research Centre awarded the Confucius Peace Prize to Putin in 2011.

Mohammad Mustafa Named as the Prime Minister of Palestinian Authority

- ii.He has previously served as Deputy PM and Minister of National Economy for the State of Palestine from **2013-2014**.
- iii.He has also held various senior positions at the World Bank in Washington, D.C., United States of America(USA), for 15 years.
- iv.He has also served as the Founding Chief Executive Officer(CEO) of the Palestine Telecoms Company (PaTel).
- v.He founded Wataniya Mobile, and Massader for Natural Resources and Infrastructure, as well as investment funds, such as the Rasmala Palestine Equity Fund and the Sharakat Fund for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises(SMEs).

- ii. Also he won the 'Darjah Utama Bakti Cemerlang (Tentera)' **Distinguished Service Order** (Military), the highest military award of Singapore.

Note: The honour recognises Bharti Enterprises’ work within the India-UK space, including with the UK government in the field of satellites.

Honorary Knighthood:

i.KBE is a distinguished recognition for pre-eminent contributions in any field of activity and is conferred in an honorary capacity to foreign nationals.

ii.While the Knighthood conferred on UK nationals gives them the titles “Sir” or “Dame.”

- The non-UK nationals awarded the honour add KBE (or Dame Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire (DBE) for women) after the recipient’s name.

About Sunil Bharti Mittal:

i.In 1976, he founded Bharti Enterprises, which started its telecom services business by launching mobile services in Delhi in 1995.

ii.Bharti Airtel, the flagship company of Bharti Enterprises, has emerged as one of the top telecom companies in the world.

ii.He is the Co-Chairman of Eutelsat Group, a global leader in satellite communications. He was the 1st Indian to be elected as Chair of the GSMA.

The 7th edition of the **Romain Rolland Book Prize(2024)** has been awarded to “**Staliner Divan**”, the Bengali translation of Jean-Daniel Baltassat’s French novel “Le Divan de Staline” (Stalin’s Couch), by **Pankaj Kumar Chatterjee**.

- The Romain Rolland Book Prize is annually presented by the French Institute in India (IFI – Institut Français en Inde) in collaboration with **Apeejay Trust**.
- The original French novel was published in 2013. The Bengali translation of the book was published by **New Bharat Sahitya Kutir** in 2023.

Note: IFI has invited the publisher and translator of Staliner Divan to participate in the **Paris Book Market** in May 2024 and **Paris Book Fair** in April 2024 respectively.

Points to note:

i.This is the **2nd Bengali book** to win the Romain Rolland Book Prize.

ii.Previously, the Romain Rolland Book Prize 2022 was won by Myorso Birudhyo Saksho, the Bengali translation of the Meursault, contre-enquête, the 1st novel by Algerian writer and

journalist Kamel Daoud, by Trinanjan Chakraborty. The book was published by Patra Bharati.

About the Book:

i. The novel 'Le Divan de Staline' is about 'Soviet leader' Joseph Stalin, who was the leader of the Soviet Union from 1924 until his death in 1953.

About Romain Rolland Book Prize:

i. Romain Rolland Book Prize was created in **2017** to recognise the best translation of a French title (francophone area) into any Indian language, including English.

ii. The award aims to encourage the efforts by Indian translators and Indian publishers to bring the best of Francophone (French) literature.

Japanese Architect Riken Yamamoto Wins Pritzker Architecture Prize 2024

Architect **Riken Yamamoto** of Yokohama, **Japan**, has been named the **2024** Laureate of the **Pritzker Architecture Prize**, the highest global architectural recognition.

- He is the **53rd laureate** of the Pritzker Architecture Prize and the **9th Japanese** architect to win the prize.
- The award includes a cash prize of USD 100,000 and a bronze medallion.

- Michel Talagrand is the **27th** recipient of the Abel Prize, also known as the Nobel Prize for Mathematics, and he is the **5th** Frenchman to receive the award.

i. Norway’s King Harald V will present the Abel Prize to Michel Talagrand at an award ceremony in Oslo, Norway on 21st May, 2024.

ii. In 2023, the Abel Prize was won by Latin American mathematician Luis A Caffarelli for his contributions to regularity theory for non-linear partial differential equations.

Shafiqur Rahman Barq: India's Oldest Lok Sabha MP Passed Away

India's oldest parliamentarian and a founding member of the Samajwadi Party (SP), **Shafiqur Rahman Barq** passed away at the age of 93 in Moradabad, Uttar Pradesh (UP). He was born on 11th July 1930 in Deepa Sarai, Sambhal, UP.

- He was serving as Member of Parliament (MP) of the 17th Lok Sabha (2019-24) representing the **Sambhal** constituency of UP.

Shafiqur Rahman Barq:

As an MP:

- i. He served as an MP for five times.
- ii. He was initially elected to 11th Lok Sabha (1996-97) from the **Sambhal** constituency.
- iii. He also represented Sambhal constituency in 12th Lok Sabha (1998-99) and 15th Lok Sabha (2009-14).
- iv. In 14th Lok Sabha (2004-09), he represented Moradabad constituency.

As an MLA:

He served as a Member Legislative Assembly (MLA) in UP for four times in the years 1974-77, 1977-80, 1985-89 and 1989-91 respectively.

Former Canadian PM Martin Brian Mulroney Passed Away

Martin Brian Mulroney, who served as the **18th** Prime Minister (PM) of Canada (1984-1993), passed away at the age of 84 in Palm Beach, Florida, the United States of America (USA). He was born on 20 March 1939 in Baie-Comeau, Quebec (Canada).

- He played a crucial role in the signing of the Canada-United States (US) Free Trade Agreement with former US President Ronald Reagan.
- The agreement was later superseded by the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) in 1994.

Note: The agreement helped boost Canadian exports and the introduction of a Goods and Services Tax (GST) in 1991.

About Martin Brian Mulroney:

- i. Before entering politics, he served as President of the Iron Ore Company of Canada.
- ii. In 1983, he won a parliamentary seat in Nova Scotia and assumed the leadership of the Progressive Conservative Party. He also served as the Leader of the Official Opposition in the House of Commons.
- iii. In 1984, he took office as the 18th PM of Canada and was re-elected in 1988.

- He became the 1st Canadian PM in 35 years to win successive majority governments, and the 1st Conservative PM to do so in a century.



- iv. He resigned in June 1993, having served almost 9 years as PM, and rejoined the Montreal law firm of Norton Rose Fulbright (formerly Ogilvy Renault) as Senior Partner.
- v. He co-chaired the United Nations (UN) World Summit for Children in 1990.
- vi. In 2014, he was named chairman of Quebecor Inc., a Montreal (Canada)-based media company.

Recognitions and Honours:

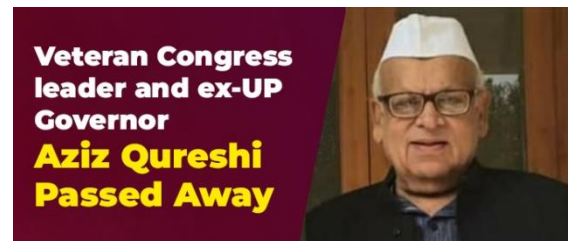
- i. He was awarded Canada's highest honour, Companion of the Order of Canada in 1998.
- ii. He was presented with the Global Citizen Award by the UN Association in Canada (2001).
- iii. He received the highest honour of the Government of Quebec, Grand officier de l'Ordre national du Québec (2002).
- iv. He received the Woodrow Wilson Award for Public Service in 2003.
- v. In 2018, he was honoured with the George Bush Award for Excellence in Public Service.
- vi. In 2019, he also received the James A. Baker III Prize for Excellence in Leadership.

Senior Congress Leader Aziz Qureshi Passed Away

Senior Congress leader **Aziz Qureshi**, who served as Governor of Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, and Mizoram, passed away at the age of 83 in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. He was born on 24th April 1940 in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.

About Aziz Qureshi:

- i. In 1959, he was the founder member and first General Secretary of the Indian Youth Congress in Bhopal.
- ii. In 1980, he served as Secretary of the Madhya Pradesh Congress Election Committee.
- iii. From 1981-84, he served as Chairman of Madhya Pradesh State Fisheries Development Corporation, Bhopal, with the status of Cabinet Minister.
- iv. He was a Member of the Madhya Pradesh Legislative Assembly from 1972-77.
- v. In 1972, he was first elected as a Member of the Legislative Assembly (MLA) from the Sehore seat in Madhya Pradesh.
- vi. He served as a Member of Parliament (MP – Lok Sabha) from 1984 to 1989. He was elected from Satna constituency of Madhya Pradesh.
- vii. He served as Governor of Uttarakhand from 2012-2015; and Governor of Mizoram from January 2015 to March 2015. He served as Governor (Additional charge) of Uttar Pradesh from 23 June 2014 to 22 July 2014.



Japan Manga Creator Akira Toriyama Passed Away

Akira Toriyama, one of the most famous Japanese comic (manga) artists and character designers, passed away. He was born on 05th April 1955 in Nagoya, Japan.

- He was the creator of **Dragon Ball**, one of the most influential and best-selling manga.
- In 2019, Toriyama received Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres (Knight of the Order of Arts and Letters) from the French government for his contributions to the arts.

Former Navy Chief Admiral L Ramdas Passes Away

Former Chief of Naval Staff (CNS), Admiral Laxminarayana Ramdas, passed away at the age of 90 in Secunderabad Military Hospital, Telangana. He was born on 5th September 1933 in Matunga, Bombay(now Mumbai, Maharashtra).

About L Ramdas:

Indian Navy Career:

- i. He joined the Indian Navy in 1953. He played a major role in the 1971 India-Pakistan war as the commander of the Indian Naval Ship (INS) Beas, a part of the Eastern Fleet.
- ii. He served as the Indian Naval Attache in Bonn, West Germany from 1973 to 1976.
- iii. He also served as the Fleet Commander of the Eastern Naval Command and commanded both the Southern and Eastern Naval Commands.
- iv. He served as the 13th CNS of the Indian Navy from December 1990 to September 1993.
- v. Prior to his retirement in 1993, he served as the Chairman of the Chiefs of Staff Committee.

Retirement life:

i. In 1994, He partnered with 24 like-minded Indians and Pakistanis in Lahore to open a public dialogue for reconciliation and peace. This led to the formation of Pakistan-India Peoples' Forum for Peace and Democracy(PIPPFD).

- He served as the vice-chair of the India branch of PIPPF and became chair in 1996.
- ii. He was also actively involved in the Indo-Pakistan Soldiers Initiative for Peace (IPSI), and the anti-nuclear peace movement Coalition for Nuclear Disarmament and Peace (CNDP).

Awards:

- i. He was honoured with **Vir Chakra (1971)**, the third-highest gallantry award, for his role in the 1971 Indo-Pakistani war
- ii. He received the Ramon Magsasay Award for Peace and International Understanding in 2004 for his efforts to build peace between Pakistan and India. He shared the award with Ibn Abdur Rehman, founding chair of the Pakistan branch of PIPPF.

Psychologist Daniel Kahneman, a Nobel Laureate in Economic Sciences Passed Away

Daniel Kahneman, Renowned Israeli-American and the first and only psychologist to win a Nobel Prize(Economics), passed away at the age of 90. He was born on 5 March 1934, in Tel Aviv, British Mandate of Palestine (now Israel).

Awards/Honours:

i. He won the **Nobel Prize in Economic Science** – formally known as The **Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobe** in 2002 for integrating insights from psychological research into economic science, especially concerning human judgment and decision-making under uncertainty.



- He shared the award with an American economist **Vernon Lomax Smith**.
- ii. In 2007, he received the Lifetime Contribution Award from the American Psychological Association.
- iii. He received the United States of America(USA)'s Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2013

About Daniel Kahneman:

i.Dr. Kahneman held the position of professor of psychology at the:

- Hebrew University in Jerusalem (1970-1978);
- University of British Columbia (UBC), Canada (1978-1986); and
- University of California, Berkeley, United States (US) (1986-1994).

ii.He was the Eugene Higgins Professor of Psychology Emeritus, and a professor of psychology and public affairs at the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs (now SPIA), at Princeton University, New Jersey, US since 1993.

iii.He has authored several books and some of his notable works include:

- Thinking, Fast and Slow (2011); Co-author of Noise: A Flaw in Human Judgment (2021), among others.

kidneys to overall health and equitable access to care and medication for all.

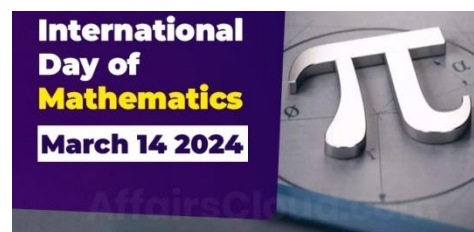
- WKD also aims to raise awareness of kidney disease and to reduce the impact of kidney disease and its associated health problems.

World Meteorological Day 2024 – March 23

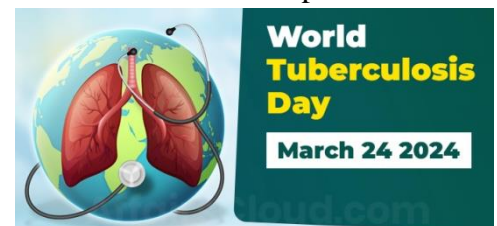

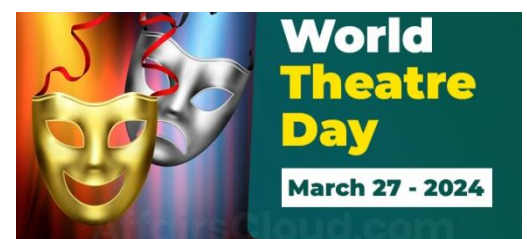
- The **2024 theme** of World Tuberculosis Day is, **"Yes! We can end TB,"** which is the continuation of the 2023 theme.
